



Music Achievement Award

30-Piece Challenge



The Music Achievement Award can be earned by completing the 30-Piece Challenge.

The focus is to learn a number of pieces to a proficient level. All students will be eligible for this award at the end of the year and there will be no fee involved!

Here are the rules:

1. Music must be at least 8 measures long for first-year students (16 if you have taken piano more than one year).
2. Music may be of all kinds of levels and styles.
3. Music must be performed accurately including notes, rhythm, and dynamics.
4. Pieces that were used as sight reading in the lessons may be practiced and performed at the next lesson to count toward the total.
5. Pieces do not need to be memorized.

Students completing the 30-piece challenge will receive a certificate and medal at the end of the year.

Students exceeding the 30-piece threshold may work on Musicathlon goals for an additional award.
