Extracurricular Event Descriptions

Theory Exam

Students complete weekly written theory assignments and ear training drills in preparation to take the MSTMA theory exam, a written test given in March. There are 12 different levels and students are placed according to age, length of study, etc. Fee: \$30 per level (includes registration plus workbook)

Keyboard Exam

Students practice six different technical areas of piano playing: scales/arpeggios, transposition, improvisation, harmonization, and sight reading in preparation to take the MSTMA Keyboard Musicianship exam, a judged event held in December. Event fee: \$15

Music Achievement Award

I am participating in a program designed by my professional organization, Music Teachers National Association, which is offered to all the students in my music studio.
