What You Will Need:

- Stain
- Cotton swabs or a small art brush

Directions:

Apply a small amount of stain to a cotton swab or small art brush. Lightly brush the stain over the area needing to be repaired and wipe away the excess. Let the spot dry. Reapply lightly if needed. ****NOTE:** In some instances, you may need to dilute the stain with 50% water and follow the above steps until you have reached the desired color.
