To parents:

What we learned:



Today, we learned that going through difficult times enables us to grow. We can use the difficult situations we've gone through in the past to help others with similar problems. Our prior experience may be just the thing we need to help understand what someone else is going through and allow us to compassionately come to their aid. (Scripture used: Romans 15:1-2, 2 Corinthians 1:3-5, James 1:27)

Memory Verse:

Ask your child to share his or her thoughts on the verse; what does it mean to him or her? How might we apply it to our lives today? Read the verse, with your child, several times during the next week.
