To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



What we learned:

Today, the children learned that the best way for people to see Jesus in them is to let people see Jesus through them. That means doing what Jesus would do. Christian living requires having the right attitudes and behaviors. (Scripture used: John 13:1-17)



Memory Verse:

**"Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity."
1 Timothy 4:12 NIV**

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help him or her remember the verse and it will also help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Choose several chores around the house that need to be done. Ask your child how long it would take to finish each task. Then cut the time in half. If they complete each chore in the allotted time, they get a treat. For each minute they are able to finish before the allotted time, they get additional treats. Remind them this is a game. In real life, having a good attitude and showing good behavior has its own rewards.

Dear Lord, help me to have the right attitude and behavior. When I say thank you, let me really mean it. When I'm asked to do something, help me do it without grumbling or trying to put it off until later. Let me speak the truth, and to be there for someone who needs me. Let others see You through me.
