To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today, the children discovered the importance of keeping their eyes on Jesus and their faith in Him to avoid falling into trouble. We saw how when Peter took his eyes off Jesus, he began to fall into the water. Living life as a Christian doesn't mean we will be able to walk on water, but we will be able to do whatever it is that Jesus wants us to do. (Scripture used: Matthew 14:22-32)

Memory Verse:



"fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." Hebrews 12:2 NASB

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help him or her remember the verse and it will also help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Take your child to a busy mall or shopping center one day this week, and take along your Bible. Find somewhere to sit in a very busy area and read a few passages. Ask your child a few questions to see how he or she does. Then, on another day, find a quiet place to go such as a library or park, and read another Bible passage. Ask questions again and see the difference. Relate this to how we need to avoid distractions to keep our eyes on Jesus.
