To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today, the children discovered an important truth about living a Christian life. They must walk down the narrow path of righteousness, avoiding ungodly influences and temptations along the way. We talked about three things to help stay on the right path. Reading the Bible to know the Truth, memorizing scripture to use God's Word to resist the devil, and praying regularly for Jesus to be our guide. (Scripture used: Matthew 4:1-11)

Memory Verse:

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help him or her remember the verse and it will also help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Along with your child, make a list of ways they can follow Jesus instead of what the rest of the world does. Have them commit to doing two or three items on their list this week.

Here are some examples:

1. Thank Jesus first for each meal instead of digging right in
2. Read my Bible in the evening instead of watching Television
3. Say something nice about another person instead of gossiping
