

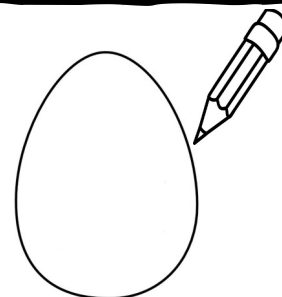

- Jesus' death MUST have been important.

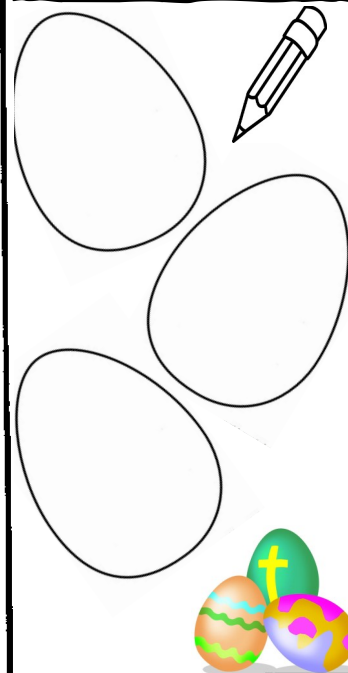

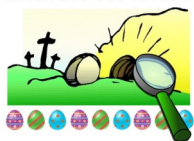

COMMUNION

- One way in which churches remember Easter is by celebrating the meal that Jesus had with his friends.
- This celebration has different names: Mass, Holy Communion, Last Supper, Lord's Supper or Breaking of Bread – but they are all to remember Jesus' death.

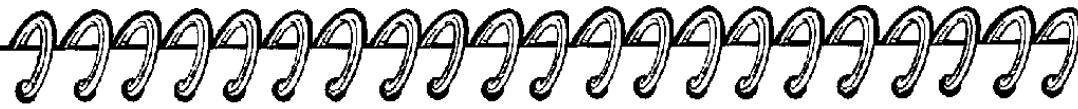
- Most Christians believe **Communion** is very important.

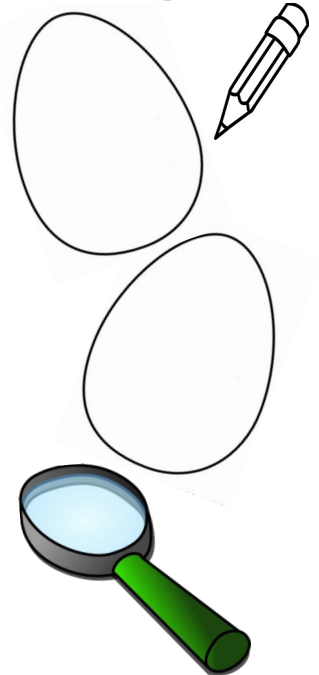

BAPTISM
