

Teacher's notes

- The activities we've included are designed to support spiritual, personal and social development.
- These suggestions are for use by pupils on their own, with others in class or as a whole school project.
- There are ideas to help both explore and reflect on the story and it's relevance to us

Bible references: Matthew 28. 16-20, Acts 1. 1-11

Aims: To explore and reflect on how Jesus' friends coped in challenging situations by believing that God's Holy Spirit and Jesus were with them during those times, linking ideas to our own lives and exploring what we need to help us face challenges.

thinas to do!

Focus: Considering what 'tools' are needed for challenging situations, exploring where would like to go.

Activities: 1. Where will you go? 2. Suitcase for life 3. Secret Code.

Resources: Suitcase template, paper for 'Where will you go?', secret code sheet.

The Code is based on Matthew 28: 16-20. The code reads: 'Jesus is always with us' and 'presence'.

thinas to do!

Focus: Identifying helpful advice and reflecting on the idea of God being with you.

Activities: 1. Top Tips 2. Shadows.

Resources: Post it notes or small pieces of paper for Top Tips, Shadow pictures, chalk.

- With the Top Tips you might also get the children to offer top tips for dealing with specific problems.
- With the shadows: if you can go outdoors you will need chalk for drawing around shadows and produce some amazing pictures! If the weather doesn't allow, maybe you can set up some shadows indoors to look at and even photograph.
- There are some images of shadows attached to use on the class screen if you need to.

thina to do!

Focus: Celebrating the theme of our assemblies for the year with some fun!

Activities: 1. Power in Me song and dance.

Resources: See 2 video clip options to show-both show the lyrics.

- Although you may not be allowed to sing, the dancing should feel celebratory.
- You might suggest that each class come with some 'moves' to lead the dancing.

Jesus told his friends to go around their country and also to other countries to tell people about Jesus.


- If you could go anywhere, where would you like to go?

Think of your answers to the questions in this suitcase, then write or draw your answers in the big suitcase attached.




3: Secret Code


See whether you can decipher the code using the sheet attached, to find out what that belief was?

Some activities to help your class to explore the ideas in our assembly

1: Top tips

What advice have people given you that you have found helpful or important? This could be something that family, friends, or school have taught you.

Which top tips have you heard today from the assembly or others in the class that you think would be helpful?

 Play a 'shopping list' memory game in class, listing 'top-tips' and see how many top tips can be remembered in one list!



 Combine your ideas and write the top tips on post-it notes or paper and stick them onto an A3 piece of paper to make a display.

2: Shadows

Have a discussion in class about what difference it makes to know someone is with you, using the suggestions below. Then go outside to draw some shadows.

Jesus said "I will always be with you" and in the assembly you heard examples of Jesus' followers saying that God or Jesus was with them.

- What do you think about the idea of God/Jesus/the Holy Spirit always being with you? What difference does it make?
- Think about your shadow and how it is connected to you whenever you move it moves with you. Think of words to describe your shadow.







- If you are able to go outside, move around and see what your shadow does. Someone can draw around your shadow on the ground. If inside, then look at the shadow pictures attached.
- Discuss as a class what our thoughts about shadows could this tell us about God?

1: Power in me

Over this past year in our "Power to ..." assemblies, we have been reflecting on how Jesus sent the Holy Spirit of God to his friends and gave them:
