Highlights of the Paris 2025 programme include:

- A private guided tour of the Bourse de Commerce (Fondation Pinault)
- A bohemian art workshop in the former art studio of Henri Matisse
- A Hammam steam bath at the Grand Mosque of Paris

Arrival In Paris: wed 5th November

Evening: join us for a bistrot dinner and meet the group.

Day One: museum & gallery visits

Morning: private tour of the Musée d'Art Moderne, with contemporary curator, Susan Power, and a visit to the Petit-Palais. <u>Afternoon</u>: guided tour of the Bourse du Commerce (Pinault Collection) by a museum curator, and an art tour in the Marais. <u>Evening</u>: dinner at a traditional bistrot.

Day Two: studio visits, market & spa

Morning: visit to the Musée Eugène Delacroix, an open air food market, and a bohemian art workshop in the studio of Henri Matisse! <u>Afternoon</u>: studio visits and a walk through Montparnasse, ending with a Hammam steam bath at the Grand Mosque of Paris.

Day Three: optional visits

Morning: optional visit (not included) to the Louis Vuitton art collection and/or the newly relocated Foundation Cartier art collection.

Note: this programme is indicative and will be confirmed later.



Fees and Booking

What is included?

- All services of art curator, Jolanda Chandler.
- Guided tours and entry tickets to museums/studios (except for Day Three, Sat 8th November, where visits will not be included).
- All additional curatorial or guided contributions by external guests.
- Two-course bistrot dinner on the evening of arrival in Paris.
- Two-course lunch on Day One.
- Two-course bistro dinner on Day One.
- Art workshop on Day Two.
- Hammam steam baths at the grand Mosque, including tea, on Day Two.

What is not included?

- Transport costs.
- Lunch at the open-air food market and dinner on Day Two.
- Accommodation (once your spot is confirmed, we'll share suggestions).
- Alcohol (guests are welcome to make their own arrangements).
