Only authorised users will have access to this information who abide by our data protection policy to ensure the secure processing of your personal data. All data is held on secure servers located within the EU.

This information will only be used in response to a specific request and will not be shared with any third party unless we have gained permission to do so. Information may also be collected via online forms that are submitted to us.

We may use this information and / or collect personal information in order to send you relevant information to the email you have supplied. We will undertake this is in full accordance with both GDPR and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR).

We will also not pass on your details to any third party unless specifically requested by yourself.

You may also contact us to request what information we hold about you. Under GDPR we have to respond within 30 days.

Cookie Policy

As is common with most websites, this site uses cookies. A cookie is a small piece of text downloaded to your computer and is designed to improve your browsing experience.
