FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AT LINCOLN TRAIL COLLEGE

Lincoln Trail College prides itself on offering an educational experience that is among the best in the nation^{*} at a price that is the most accessible in the state. We want higher education to be accessible to everyone. Both the college and the Lincoln Trail College Foundation have a variety of **scholarships and awards** available for area residents. <u>Whether you are a high school</u> student, current LTC student, or someone who is thinking about coming back to school, we have options available for you. Please review the section below that best describes your current situation.

I am thinking about enrolling at LTC and want to know what support is available.

Student loans are one of the fastest growing categories of consumer debt in the nation. There is a better way forward at Lincoln Trail College. Our **merit-based** scholarships are highly competitive and are awarded to students who have distinguished themselves through their performance in and out of the classroom. Our **need-based** scholarships include financial aid and scholarships that consider both the academic merit and financial needs of students. Attending college can be an expensive proposal, and our need-based scholarships are intended to help cover some of the costs associated with earning your degree or certificate.

MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Lincoln Trail College makes four primary merit-based scholarships available for high-school seniors; 1) The Crawford County Award for Excellence (CCAE), 2) The Presidential Academic Scholarship Award (PASA), 3) The Student Academic Scholarship Award (SASA), 4) Principal's Choice Award (PCA). CCAE and Principal's Choice Awards require no application.

The Lincoln Trail College Foundation also has several merit based scholarships available for any student who is considering enrolling at LTC. You don't need to apply for a specific scholarship, but your letter should make a concerted effort to inform the committee how your background makes you a candidate for merit-based aid. **Everyone who wants to be considered for a merit-based scholarship should complete the General Scholarship Application (page 2) by the specified deadlines.** Please note - only a limited number of PASA and SASA scholarships are awarded, and students are highly encouraged to submit their application by the **priority deadline**.

NEED-BASED AID

The generous support of friends and alumni of Lincoln Trail College allows the Foundation to offer a variety of scholarships to help you pay for college. If you need assistance in covering the cost of attendance – large or small – you should complete the **General Scholarship Application** (page 2) by the specified deadlines. A limited pool of money is available every year. You are strongly encouraged to complete your application before the **priority deadline**.

<u>OTHER</u>

Our financial aid office is here to assist students in putting together a financial aid package that could include a mix of federal, state, institutional and private aid. Some sources of aid, like certain Foundation scholarships, the Monetary Award Program (MAP), and Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG) have limited pools of money available that go to the **students who apply first**. All graduating high school students should visit the Lincoln Trail College Financial Aid office <u>as</u> **soon as possible** to explore the types of state or federal aid that may be available.

I'm a current Lincoln Trail College student.

Current LTC students should maintain excellent communication with their academic advisor and the financial aid office to remain informed of scholarships that are available to them. Current students are eligible for support based on academic performance or financial need. The **General Scholarship Application** (page 2) lists the deadlines for applying.

I have an emergency and I need help.

The **IMPROVING LIVES SCHOLARSHIP** (page 9) is available to residents of **Crawford County only** who are enrolled at Lincoln Trail College. The primary focus of this scholarship is to address the financial hurdles associated with continuing education. Preference will be given to single parents with financial needs associated with childcare/daycare expenses; however all **unanticipated** financial needs that are prohibiting Crawford County residents from achieving educational goals will be considered during the awarding process of this scholarship. Award amounts will vary based on the needs of the selected candidates.

I am graduating LTC and I'm not sure how I'm going to pay for the next two years of school.

The Foundation offers the **Clara Mullen Memorial Scholarship** (page 6). This is a scholarship available to a Crawford County High School graduate who also graduated from Lincoln Trail College and will be working toward a Bachelor of Science or a Bachelor of Arts Degree. This is a merit-based scholarship in which the student is required to maintain a minimum GPA of 3.25.
