- □ Jonathon Acree A \$500 scholarship to be given to a Robinson High school student enrolled full-time at Lincoln Trail College in a vocational program.
- \*John Arabatgis Scholarship One variable amount scholarship to be awarded to a former inmate of a state or federal prison. Must enroll in a minimum of 6 credit hours at Lincoln Trail College and be a Crawford County resident.
- \*Larry E. Beabout Jr. Scholarship Fund A \$500 Scholarship to a full-time LTC sophomore making satisfactory progress with at least a 2.0 GPA during their freshman year. Must be a Crawford County graduate who plans to attain a bachelor's degree.
