

LTC Foundation Scholarships & Guidelines

* **Jonathon Acree** - A \$500 scholarship to be given to a Robinson High school student enrolled full-time at Lincoln Trail College in a vocational program.

* **John Arabatgis Scholarship** - One variable amount scholarship to be awarded to a former inmate of a state or federal prison. Must enroll in a minimum of 6 credit hours at Lincoln Trail College and be a Crawford County resident.

* **Larry E. Beabout Jr. Scholarship Fund** - A \$500 Scholarship to a full-time LTC sophomore making satisfactory progress with at least a 2.0 GPA during their freshman year. Must be a Crawford County graduate who plans to attain a bachelor's degree.

* **Jerry D. Carey Memorial Scholarship fund** - One or two \$500 scholarships per year for full-time students from Crawford County making satisfactory progress, with preference given to Hutsonville High School graduates.

Carpenters Local 243 Scholarship - One \$1000 scholarship, when funds are sufficient, to a member, members spouse, child or step-child. Member must be in good standings of Carpenters Local 243. Must full-time or part-time student making satisfactory progress.

Alberta Trousdale Eagleton Scholarship Fund - Variable scholarships and amounts will be awarded to full-time LTC students maintaining at least a 2.00 GPA who are enrolled in English 1121 or a literature class each semester while receiving award.

First Robinson Savings Bank Scholarship - FRSB will award \$3,500 in a scholarship(s) to full or part-time students that are enrolled at Lincoln Trail College. This scholarship is based on need as determined by the scholarship committee and upon recommendation go the Executive Director.

Evelyn Harmon Memorial Scholarship - A \$500 scholarship to be given to a student enrolled full-time at Lincoln Trail College.

Hershey Tech. Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship to a full-time student with a 2.00 GPA in a manufacturing related program.

Hershey Scholarship - One \$500 scholarship to a full-time student with a 2.00 GPA in any area of study.

Thelma Holly Memorial Nursing Scholarship - A variable amount scholarship(s) to be awarded to an LTC student that has been accepted into the nursing program as delivered at Lincoln Trail College.

* **Hutsonville Chamber of Commerce** - A \$500 scholarship to a graduate of Hutsonville High School who is attending Lincoln Trail College full-time and making satisfactory progress.

Illinois Health Improvement Association Scholarship - Variable amount scholarship(s) to an Illinois resident enrolled full or part-time at Lincoln Trail College. Scholarship may be applied toward tuition fees, books, study guides or daily expenses directly related to the health field curricula at the discretion of the LTC Foundation.

* **Doc & Dorothy Inboden Nursing Scholarship** - A \$750 nursing scholarship to a Crawford County graduate enrolled full-time at Lincoln Trail College, studying nursing or other medical related programs programs. Must maintain at least a 3.0 GPA and show financial need as determined by the LTC Foundation.

Doug & Janice Kincaid Scholarship –Variable amount scholarships are available for either full time or part time students attending Lincoln Trail College. The amount of the scholarship will be based on need.

William G. Little & Myrtle Little Memorial Scholarship – A \$1,000 scholarship for a deserving, full time LTC student who wants to enter a career in teaching making satisfactory progress with at least a 2.5 GPA. Recipient will be enrolled in a transfer degree program at LTC.

Marathon Corporate Scholarship - Up to \$1,500 for an individual enrolled in the Process Technology program at Lincoln Trail College. The individual must be a female or minority pursuing a degree with the intent to work in the energy industry and maintain a 3.0 GPA or above.

Marathon Female/Minority Scholarship - Variable amount scholarships to be awarded, as needed, with no strict deadlines. Scholarships awarded to Female/Minority students enrolled in Process Technology or Welding at Lincoln Trail College maintaining a 3.00 GPA out of a possible 4.00 GPA with intent to work in the energy industry.

Opiela Family Nursing Scholarship - A variable scholarship awarded annually to a nursing or a pre-nursing student attending classes delivered at Lincoln Trail College . Student may be enrolled full or part-time. Recipient must earn at least 2.0 GPA or better to maintain the scholarship.

Plumbers & Steamfitters Local #157 Members Memorial Scholarship Fund – One \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a student who will be enrolled in at least six semester hours of credit at LTC. Applicant must possess a minimum 3.0 GPA and be a member of Plumbers & Steamfitters Local #157 or their legal spouse, child, step-child or grandchild. Needs to be in good standing and demonstrating financial need.

Dwight E. & Helen J Prince Memorial Scholarship – A \$500 scholarship awarded annually to a full or part-time LTC student interested in pursuing a degree in either Accounting or Art.

***David T Pulliam Scholarship** – A variable scholarship awarded annually to no more than four student's applying to Lincoln Trail College for Welding, Process Technology, Petroleum Drilling or broadband telecom. Recipients must be a Crawford County graduate, maintain full time status, earn at least a 2.0 GPA and demonstrate financial need. The amount of the awards and number of recipients will be determined by the income generated from the principle.

***Josh Rodgers Memorial Scholarship** - One \$1,000 scholarship to be awarded annually to Crawford County High school graduate enrolled in full or part-time nursing classes delivered at Lincoln Trail college. The award is to be based on need as determined by the Lincoln Trail College Foundation.

***Robinson Kiwanis Club Foundation, Inc.** - One \$500 scholarship to a Robinson High School graduate, with preference to a Key Club Member. Awarded to a full or part-time LTC student.

***Robinson Rotary Club Scholarship** - A \$500 scholarship to a Lincoln Trail College - full or part-time student who is a Robinson High School graduate, with preference to an interact club member.

***Robert L. Rogers / Sharon Highsmith Memorial Scholarship** - One \$750 scholarship, when earnings are sufficient, will be awarded to a deserving Oblong High School graduate who is enrolled full-time at LTC and making satisfactory progress.

Rural King Vocational Scholarship – A \$1000 scholarship is available to a non-traditional student enrolled in a Lincoln Trail College vocation/technical program.

***Kelly Slunaker & Mildred (Shaw) Slunaker Memorial Scholarship Fund** - A variable amount scholarship will be awarded based on the income generated by the principle. Students must be enrolled full-time at Lincoln Trail College and a resident of Crawford County, IL. Applicants should also demonstrate financial needs as determined by the LTC Foundation.

***William & Elizabeth (Slunaker) Smith Scholarship** - A variable amount scholarship will be awarded based on the income generated by the principle. Students must be enrolled full-time at Lincoln Trail College and a resident of Crawford County, IL. Applicants should also demonstrate financial needs as determined by the LTC Foundation.

Ray & Lois (Spencer) Smith - A variable amount scholarship will be awarded based on the income generated by the principle. Students must be enrolled full-time at Lincoln Trail College and a resident of Crawford County, IL. Applicants should also demonstrate financial needs as determined by the LTC Foundation.

Walter F. Schmidt Scholarship - Variable amount scholarships awarded to Crawford County high school graduates. Preference is given to full-time students and those seeking a medical related career through Lincoln Trail College.

Joann Strange Scholarship – Variable amount scholarships awarded to full-time Lincoln Trail College students. Preference given to students that demonstrate financial need as determined by the LTC Foundation.

Pauline Parker Scholarships/Fund - This is a scholarship fund. This can be awarded in variable amounts with no restrictions of full-time, part-time or GPA. The LTC foundation Executive Director and LTCF scholarship committee will have the discretion to award these scholarships depending on funds available.

Ivan and Mary Lou Miller Scholarships/Fund – Multiple scholarships are available at variable amounts to LTC students who are making satisfactory progress.

Foundation Scholarships awarded by Athletic Director and Music Director at LTC

Richard Bollinger Baseball Scholarship - \$1,000 scholarship awarded annually to a Lincoln Trail College baseball player who is making satisfactory progress. Deadline is June 15.

Kathryn A Duncan Sports Scholarship – One \$1,000 Scholarship awarded annually to an athlete attending LTC full-time and making satisfactory progress. Deadline is June 15.

Parker - Ragon Athletic Scholarship – Scholarships awarded to LTC female athletes who are making satisfactory progress.

Audria Truelove Scholarship - \$250 scholarship award to assist Lincoln Trail College softball player. Award recipient shall be chosen by LTC softball coach.

Evans – Kuebler Performing Arts Scholarship – One \$1,000 or two \$500 scholarships to be awarded to full-time students who are enrolled in music or drama class.

Frankie & Garland Flick Music Fund - \$500 scholarships will be awarded, by Music Dept., to deserving music majors. Deadline is June 15.

Other Foundation Scholarships

**United Way & LTC Foundation emergent financial need scholarship: (anytime)

Improving Lives Scholarship - Awarded to CRAWFORD COUNTY RESIDENTS enrolled at LTC only. Intended to help students with unanticipated financial needs prohibiting them from remaining enrolled. Preference will be given to single parents with financial needs associated with childcare/expenses. Award amounts will vary based on the needs of the selected candidates.

**LTC Graduate/Transfer Scholarship: (June 15)

Clara Mullen Memorial Scholarship - Applicants for this scholarship must have attained a high school diploma from one of the public school systems of Crawford County, Illinois (provide an official transcript) and be a graduate of Lincoln Trail College (provide and official transcript). The amount of the award will be determined by the income generated by the trust and the number of awards given. Scholarship is to be used to defray the cost of education while working towards a Bachelor of Science or a Bachelor of Arts degree.
