Dear friends of the Rochester Gay Men's Chorus,

We have all been watching and monitoring the community situation with the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak. The RGMC values not only its dedicated patrons and donors but our singing, dancing, and volunteer membership as well. **To that end, based on recommendations from health officials and ongoing responses, we are announcing the postponement of the Elton concert, scheduled for March 28 and 29, 2020.**

We know this is a disappointing decision but it is one that is borne out of necessity. Our chorus members are extremely disappointed, having rehearsed the last two months to give you Elton, but is more determined and passionate about sharing the gift of song with you. During this time of national emergency, we are keeping a song in our hearts and our sights on the future when we can take the stage and celebrate with you. After all, it is for you, our audience, that we sing.

We are working with our partners at the Hochstein Performance Hall to secure a new date and we'll let you all know as soon as we are able to. If you have already purchased tickets for Elton, you have several options: your Elton tickets will be valid for our rescheduled date, TBA; you may request a voucher for another concert through Spring 2021; or you can consider your ticket purchase a donation to the RGMC. This is a difficult time for our communities as new information about limiting crowd sizes is affecting performing arts organizations across the world. Arts organizations are especially hit hard with cancellations and shutdowns leading to loss of revenue and the RGMC is no exception. The loss of revenue from ticket sales, sponsors, and raffle sales, among other factors, is a major challenge to our organization as we assess our plans for moving forward. We appeal to you as a friend of the chorus to join us in preserving our future.

Please consider donating to our **Spring Campaign** in raising money to support the RGMC as we face the challenges of providing for operational expenses. We are happy to share we have \$1500 in matching donations so far and hope you will donate to help us be successful in this campaign.
