Thirty-nine years later the RGMC still exists, as one of the oldest LGBTQ+ organizations in New York State.

The past 20 months has been a difficult time for businesses and charitable organizations, but the RGMC has survived! We had to cancel all in-person concerts since December 2019, which resulted in a significant loss of revenue. However, we managed to keep sharing our music through virtual performances. Our annual major fundraiser, Mardi Gras, took on a new look last year. It was a hybrid of in-person and virtual content. And thanks to the support of our sponsors and donors, we were able to raise much needed funds to ensure the continuation of the RGMC.

We were excited to announce at Mardi Gras in May, our plans to return to live, in-person concerts and events for our 2021-22 season. And today we are excited to announce our annual major fundraiser, the **Mardi Gras Masquerade Ball**, on Saturday, February 26, 2022.
