Conducting Association Meetings



Board Meetings

- Meeting agenda
- Add/Remove agenda items
- Materials
- Management Report in each meeting
- Create meeting rules about homeowner participation, such as time limits and number of homeowners who can speak on an issue



Parliamentary Procedure

- Board Portion
 - Motions, Seconds and Debate / No Deliberation without a Seconded Motion
 - > Board Discussion



Parliamentary Procedure

- Homeowner Portion
 - > After Board Discussion on Motion, prior to vote
 - > Chair recognizes
 - > Time limits
 - > Two (2) on either side
 - > Generally, do not answer questions



Parliamentary Procedure

- Homeowner Portion
 - > Chair must not permit discussions among members
 - > No interruptions
 - > Gavel and call to order to clear the room



Notice of Meetings

 Notice to the membership of Board Meetings requires at least 48 hour notice.

(any manner the board deems reasonable. What do the documents say?)

An emergency Board meeting does not require 48 hour notice
