

**Mandatory Language for Monitoring/Reporting Violation  
CHEMICAL MONITORING, ROUTINE MAJOR**

The **City of Rio Hondo** water system PWS ID **0310006** has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers, and report the results of those samples to the TCEQ on a regular basis.

We failed to monitor and/or report the following constituents Chlorine Dioxide.

This/These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period(s) August 2019.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

We are taking daily samples as to where our residuals stay in compliance. We are also sending lab samples to make sure we are in compliance.

**Instructions for Preparing the Required Public Notice:**

Recopy mandatory language above and insert the underlined information in the spaces indicated.

The TCEQ recommends that the public water system provide a copy of the Public Notice(s) to local and state officials, such as Mayors, City Council Members, County Commissioners, Judges, and/or State Representatives, that are located in or that represent the affected area(s) served by the system.

**Public Notice Delivery Timelines:**

The initial public notice shall be issued as soon as possible, but in no case later than 90 days after the violation was identified. Repeat public notice shall be issued every twelve months for as long as the violation persists. All notifications require the attached Certificate of Delivery due 10 days from the posting date of the above notice.
