

Post Hurricane Hanna Self-Reporting Survey

The City of Rio Hondo is asking that all residents take a moment and submit a damage survey through the Office of Emergency Management.

This is only necessary if your residential building or property suffered damages as a direct result of Hurricane Hanna.

This can be done either through your phone or through the online website.

The objective of this survey is to aid the Office of Emergency Management and partner agencies as they assess and identify damages and needs within the community.

Accurately reporting your location of damages will allow emergency management to prioritize recovery efforts in the most affected areas.

Reporting damage to Emergency Management is a voluntary activity and is not a substitute for reporting damage to your insurance agency nor does it guarantee disaster relief assistance.

Please submit one survey per affected address.
