



Deployment of the EBS

A simple guide to deploy your
Emergency Boat Skin

1

Unpack the EBS

Remove the EBS from the storage bag.

2

Position on the bow

Place the EBS over the bow, with the logo facing upwards.

3

Secure the rope

Secure the rope (located in the centre of the hood) to the boat.

4

Launch the EBS

Drop the EBS into the water.



5

Engage and accelerate

Put your boat in gear and accelerate forward.

6

Adjust the hull coverage

As the EBS unrolls under the hull, you can adjust it by pulling it from either side of the vessel to ensure it covers the entire hull.

7

Navigate to shore

Navigate safely back to shore, but DO NOT exceed 15 knots.

Once you have returned to shore, stop the boat and pull the EBS out from under the hull.

Maintenance instructions: Hose the EBS using fresh water to remove the salt from the seawater. Hang the EBS out to dry thoroughly before rolling up and placing back into the storage bag.

Stow the EBS with your safety equipment in a dark, dry place, where it is easily accessible.
