There are basically three options.

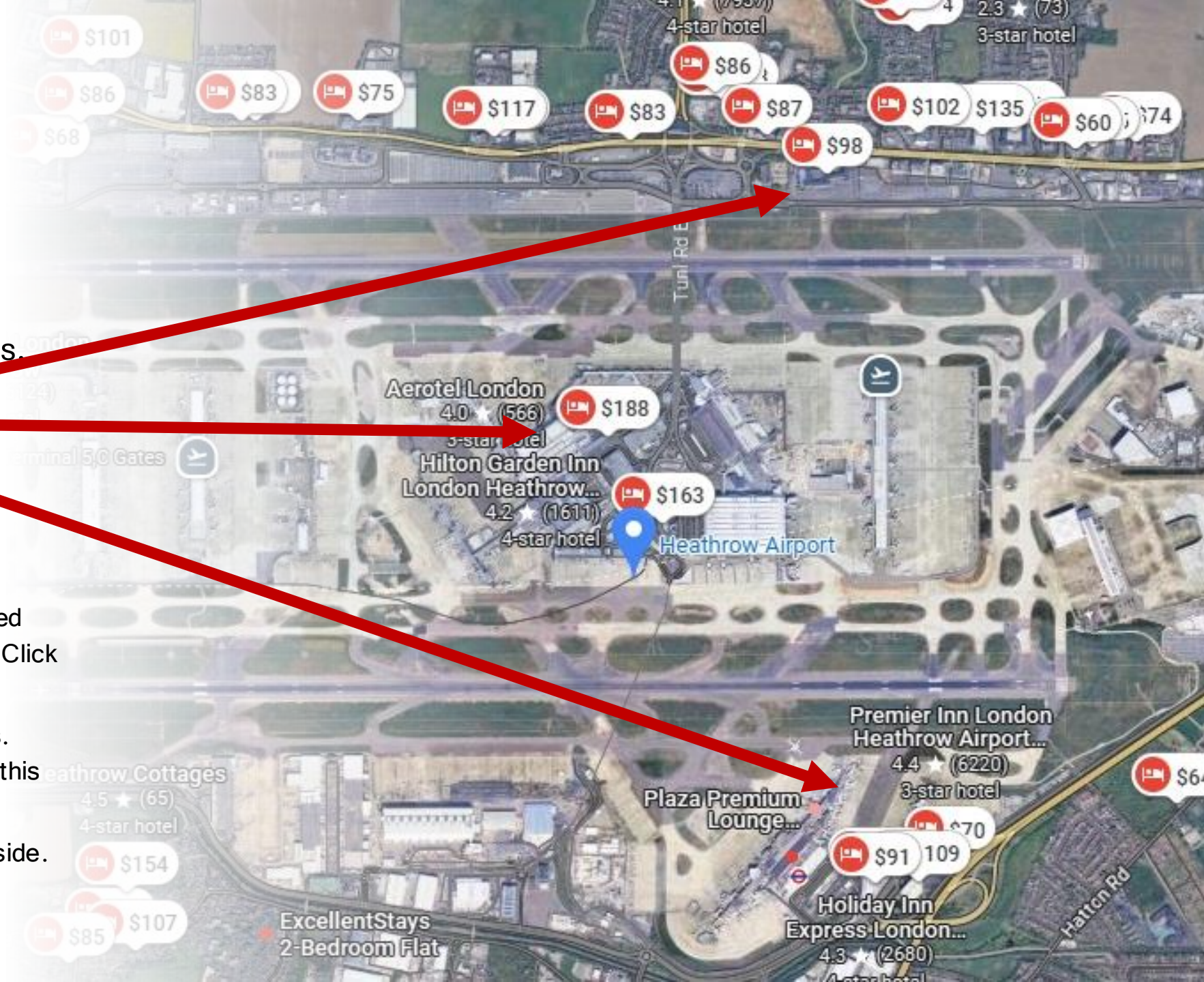
- Bath Road Hotels

# LHR Hotel Decision Guide

Hotel Location	Price	Weather Friendly	Time to Terminal 3	Board Train to Town
Bath Road	Low	No	Medium 30-60"	Far – 30-45 min
Terminal 2-3	High	Yes	Short 5-15"	Close – 5 min
Terminal 4	Low – Medium	Yes	Medium 30-45"	Close – 10-15 min

Bath Road Hotel thoughts: If the weather is good, the hotels on bath road are a good option. You can take a bus from Heathrow central bus station to and from all of them. If you have an early flight, the bus service might be limited, or the bus stop might be a bit of a walk. Use Google maps to find out what bus and stop is best. A bolt/uber from any of these hotels right to the doorstep of terminal 2, 3 or 5 is usually 10-15 dollars. Most of these hotels are withing walking distance of pubs, inexpensive dining and gas station stores to get snacks and drinks for the room.

Terminal 2-3 Hotel thoughts: Definitely the way to go if you have an early morning departure out of term 3 and want to sleep to the last minute. Walk to both terminals 2 and 3 indoors. You will pay for the convenience.

Terminal 4 Hotel thoughts: This is the budget choice for bad weather days. If you don't care about nearby amenities and just want a place to stay near the airport, this is probably the best option. You can get to all hotels and terminals staying indoors. It can take up to an hour so plan ahead.

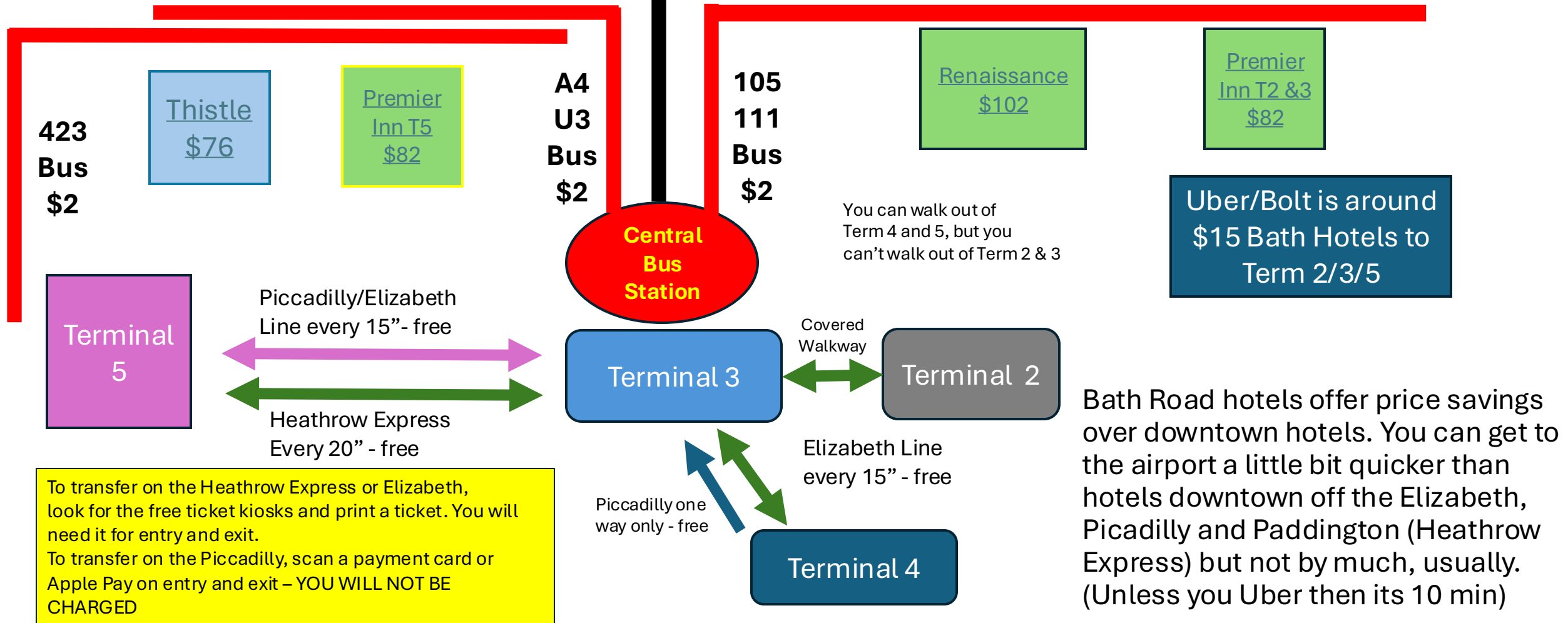

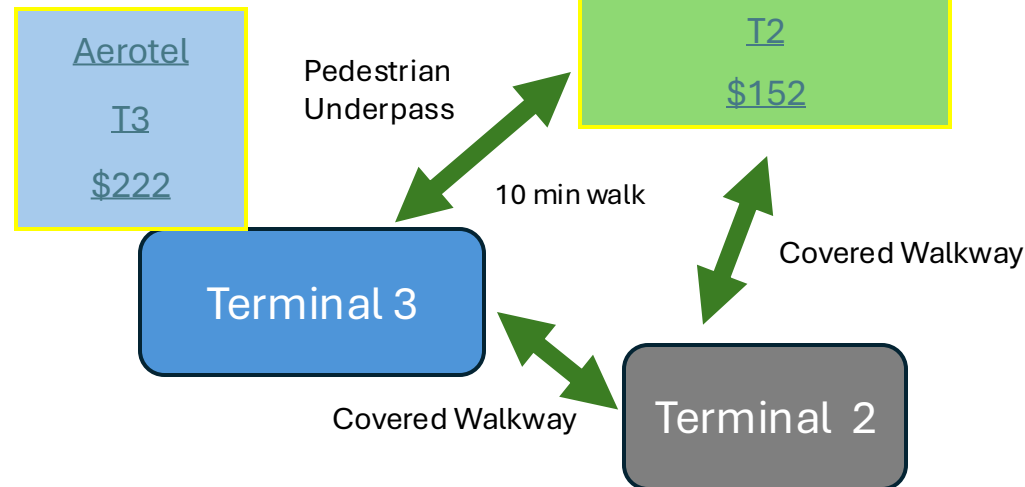




# Terminal 2-3 Hotel guide

\*Priced on a random day – Green are favorites

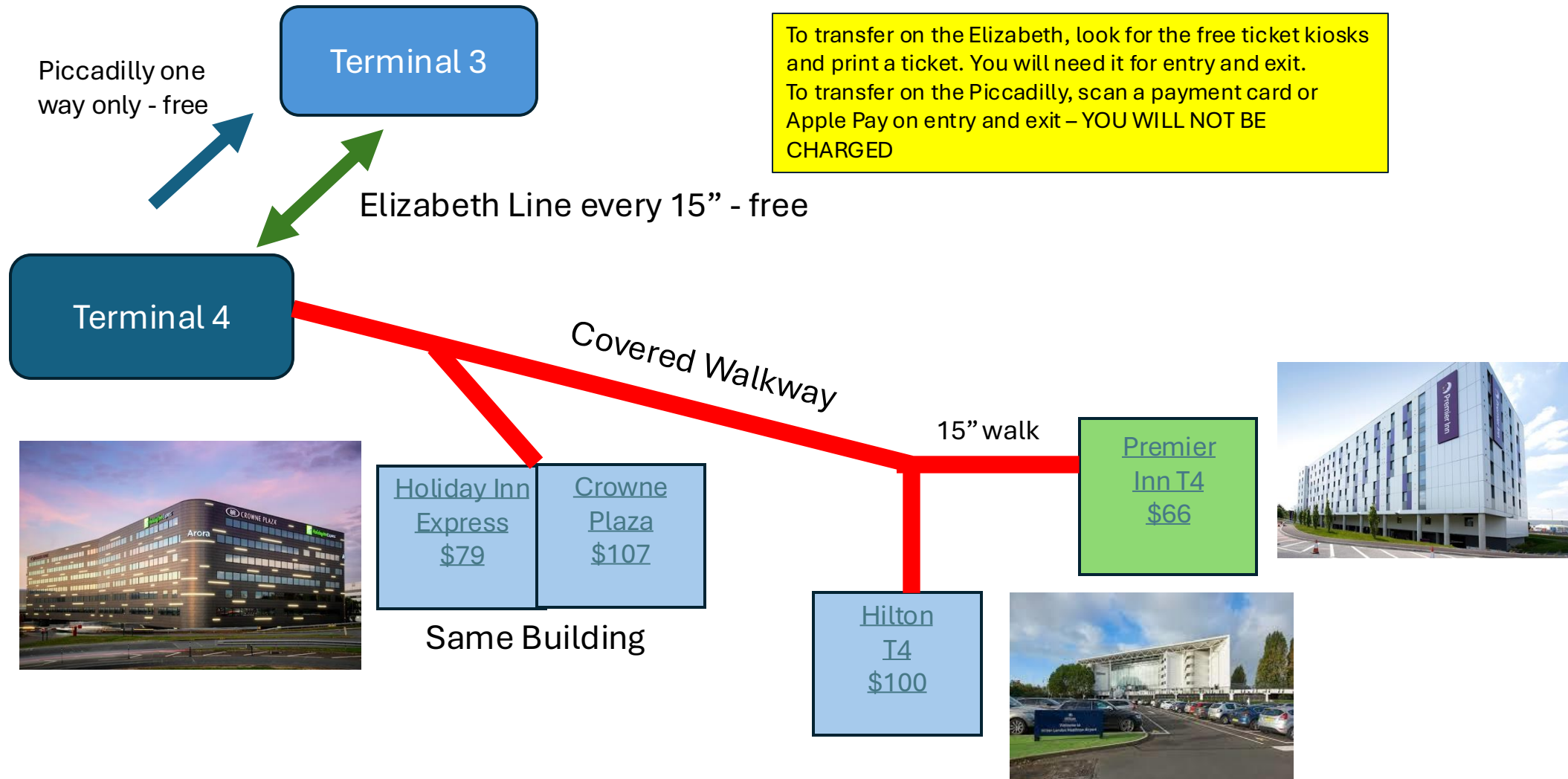
Aerotel is attached to T3 arrivals.

# FAVORITES

1. **Premier Inn T5** – T5 is next to a McDonalds for cheap breakfast and Shell station for cheap drinks and snacks for the room. You can also walk to the historic White Horse Pub. You can catch a bus right out front to get to the Piccadilly Line at Hunslow West station to get to downtown London. Premier inns have all the bells and whistles. Bar, Restaurant and room service.
2. **Hilton Garden Inn T2** – This hotel is very convenient to T3 and T2, nice rooms and the best rooftop bar in the world if you are an airplane spotter. You can see the entire airport from the bar and the view is spectacular. You have to stay here at least once. It is usually double the price of the Premier but it's for sure worth it once in a while.
3. **Premier Inn T4** – T4 is basically the same as T5 without any of the amenities to walk to. If the weather is bad, this is where I would stay. It's a 15" indoor walk to the Elizabeth line to get to town.

**Conclusion** – I have stayed at most of these hotels at LHR. I have never had a bad stay, and you really can't go wrong staying at any of them.

If you like to watch airplanes, the Thistle, Renaissance and Hilton Garden Inn T2 are your best bets.

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
