UNIONVILLE BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING – September 9, 2019 Work Session

CALL TO ORDER

A work session meeting of the Unionville Borough Council was called to order at 7:08 PM by President Allen Runkle at the Unionville Borough building located at 221 Allegheny Street, Julian, PA. Council members present included: Allen Runkle, Alisha Barton, and Bob Fisher. Members absent were Gary Dean, Brian McAfee, Fred Ream and Denny Johnson. Also present was Mayor Mimi (Angelica) Wutz, Renee Swancer, Secretary/Treasurer, Ann Carras, Water Rent Collector, Claude Confer, Darrel Hockenberry and Chris Shultz from the American Red Cross.

The regular meeting was not held because no quorum was present. Attending Council members decided to hold a work session. No decisions were made at the meeting only general discussion took place.

<u>Chris Shultz – American Red Cross.</u> Ms. Shultz attended to discuss a smoke detector replacement/installation program and home fire protection campaign the Red Cross is sponsoring. The Red Cross comes into communities and goes door-to-door to meet with home owners offering to replace existing and/or install new smoke detectors. The new smoke detectors meet all required State Codes. While meeting with home owners, Red Cross volunteers will discuss home fire protection measures and safety education. The Red Cross would like to visit Unionville Borough on October 3, 2019 between 9:00 AM to Noon. If residents are not home during this time, door hangers will be placed and home owners can contact the Red Cross to make alternative arrangements to come back. The Council members expressed their support for the program and welcomed the Red Cross to canvas on October 3rd. Ms. Shultz will provide the Secretary with information to place on the website for home owners.

<u>Snow Bids</u>. Mr. Runkle opened the snow bids and the Council reviewed the bids. Bids will be awarded at the October regular meeting.

<u>Snow Routes</u>: Council members looked at the maps for the Borough.

<u>Water Collectors Report</u>: Ms. Carras provided her report. Two shut-off notices will be sent out. A letter from Eagle Creek regarding sewer/water easement was also acknowledged.

Picnic Tables: The four new picnic tables have been taken to the park.

Water Rates: Ms. Carras and Council members discussed the existing water rates.

<u>Apartments:</u> Ms. Wutz thought it may be beneficial to have the zoning officer attend the next meeting to talk about apartments within the Borough.

New Water System Computer: The Secretary noted the new computer arrived and is ready for software installation.
