# **Burning Ordinance within Borough**

Unionville Borough does have a Burning Ordinance. Please make sure you do not violate its provisions.

The Ordinance prohibits the burning of:

**Garbage:** All animal and vegetable matter resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking and consumption of food.

**Rubbish.** All solid or liquid materials including, but not limited to rags, old clothes, leather, rubber, carpets, wood, plastics, tires, petroleum products, shingles, furniture, tin cans, glass, crockery, and similar materials.

**Trade Waste**. All solid or liquid material or rubbish resulting from construction, building operations, including but not limited to, plastic products, paint, grease oil, or other chemicals.
