### Garbage/Rubbish Accumulations: Council asks for residents to please

clean up garbage and rubbish accumulations prior to enforcement. The Borough has an ordinance prohibiting such accumulations which can cause public health concerns especially during this COVID-19 crisis.

New Water Tank: Borough Council selected an Engineer to begin design and construction drawings for the new Borough Water Tank to replace the aging water reservoirs. Construction may begin in fall of 2020. The project is funded by a Community Development Block Grant.
