3. The total weight of a dog and the dog's puppy is 36.35 kilograms. The dog weighs $31\frac{3}{4}$ kilograms. How many kilograms does the puppy weigh?

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4. A green ribbon is $2\frac{5}{8}$ inches long. A red ribbon is 6.25 inches long. What is the total length of both ribbons?

5. Miss Song keeps track of how many miles she walks each day.
