ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Everyone is anxious and excited about road work this year. We are awaiting the arrival of our road contractor which has been targeted for a start date sometime in May.

PROJECTS REPORT

The extra boat trailer parking project is nearing phase II completion and expected to be finished over the next few weeks. We are awaiting final recommendations and cost estimates for final approval from the Board of Directors. This will be a great enhancement to our boat ramp facilities. The new parking lot area needs to settle. Please feel free to drive and park on it to help pack it down. The final phase, including the chip and seal, will be completed next year.

Village pool area project involves repairs and improvements to drainage. A bid has been accepted and work is scheduled to begin after March 22, 2021. Keeping your village amenities in good order remains a priority for your Manager and Board of Directors.
