# 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Holiday Villages BBQ Cook-Off Rules June 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023

**Bloody Mary** Presentation judging will be held at Park Pavilion using containers other than the cup furnished for turn in.

**Beans** will be pinto beans only. You may use vegetables and or meat to cook with your beans, but nothing bigger than the bean itself may be turned in, in the container.

**Open Category** can be anything other than brisket, ribs, chicken, or dessert.

**Chicken** – A whole ½ chicken complete with breasts, legs and thighs attached must be turned in. PLEASE MAKE SURE CHICKEN IS DONE! Any chicken displaying bloody insides will NOT be JUDGED!

**Pork Ribs** – Ribs will be Spareribs, or St. Louis cut. <u>NO BABYBACK RIBS!</u> <u>Turn in will be (7) individual pork ribs.</u>

**Brisket** – Turn in will be (7) individual slices of Beef Brisket. <u>NO CORNED BEEF</u> BRISKET ALLOWED!

Sauces may be used while cooking the meat categories but must not be put on the meat in the container. Sauces puddling in the bottom of the container will cause entry to be sent back to be cleaned up.
