FIRST THINGS FIRST

Regarding warranty work by Waters Construction to resolve the bleeding issues on Cooke-Jones and Hidden Oaks. They applied a water/lime and aggregate treatment, on 4/26, 5/2, 5/4, 5/8, 5/19, 6/8 and 6/12. They also applied the same to the Boat Parking area just after Memorial Day. Waters also patched Cook-Jones and Hidden Oaks just before the July 4th holiday and sealing the roads will come next, however, it is not recommended at this time due to excessively hot temperatures. Waters Construction expressed sincere apologies for all of the problems. They have been, and continue to work diligently to resolve this issues.

The BOD is also looking to schedule three road projects that were on the 2022 approved list, however,

have yet to be completed. These are (1) Hidden Oaks from Gate to Hidden Cove (2) Caymen Street entrance from concrete pavement to Hidden Cove and (3) Defining the culde-sac on Amalie Court
