BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR COOK-OFF ENTRY

- 1. Each team will be limited to a maximum of three (3) people.
- 2. Each team will have a head cook who will be responsible to cook at least ½ gallon of Chili and/or Beans and turning in one (1) cup to be judged (Cups will be supplied).
- 3. Each team will supply all ingredients, utensils, and accessories to cook their chili/beans, including cooker, grill or stove.
- 4. Chili/Beans may be dispensed to the community only after judging samples have been collected at noon.
- 5. Each team must agree to the rules.
- 6. Cooking will take place from 8am to 12 noon at which time samples will be gathered for judging.

CHILI COOK-OFF OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. Meat must be cooked on site veggies may be chopped off premises. No other ingredients may be chopped or added prior to the cook-off start at 8am.
- 2. This is home style, made from scratch chili. Chili powder is permissible, but complete chili mixes are not allowed. No beans allowed.
- 3. Cooking will take place at the park across from the clubhouse.
- 4. At no time should you leave cooking chili unattended (for safety & integrity reasons).
- 5. Each team will be provided a cup with a lid and two tickets taped to the side. Remove the loose ticket and keep it safe. (This could be your winning ticket.) When the Head Judge comes around for your entry, put entry into cup in front of the Judge, not before.
- 6. Judging will be held in the clubhouse starting at noon.
- 7. All cooking must be done in a sanitary manner. Conditions will be monitored by the Head Judge. Failure to comply is subject to disqualification.

BEAN COOK-OFF OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. Dry Pinto Beans ONLY will be allowed for this cook-off. Beans may be soaked at home.
- 2. Ingredients, including bacon, meat, vegetables pieces, etc. may be used to cook with the beans, and turned in with the beans, if it is smaller than the bean itself. Entries turned in with items included larger than the bean itself will be disqualified.
- 3. Cooking will take place at the park across from the clubhouse.
- 4. At no time should you leave cooking beans unattended (for safety & integrity reasons).
- 5. Each team will be provided a cup with lid and two tickets taped to the side. Remove the loose ticket and keep it safe. (This could be your winning ticket.) When the Head Judge comes around for your entry, put entry into cup in front of Judge, not before.
- 6. Judging will be held in the clubhouse starting at noon.
- 7. All cooking must be done in a sanitary manner. Conditions will be monitored by the Head Judge. Failure to comply is subject to disqualification
