





























Keynote Speaker Haig Aintablian, MD FAAEM

Director, UCLA Space Medicine Flight Surgeon, SpaceX Medical Director, Northrop Grumman

Board-certified emergency physician, flight surgeon, and Director of UCLA's Space Medicine Program. He began college at 15 and earned both his BA and MS from USC by age 21.

With over 40 research publications—including groundbreaking work on rare genetic disorders—his contributions are cited in medical textbooks and have involved collaborations with NASA.

Haig has served in leadership roles with national medical organizations, received the 2020 "Resident of the Year" award, and provided frontline combat medicine in Armenia. He's been featured in major media outlets including KTLA, BBC, and *The New York Times*.
