

James M. Codd died on November 15th, 2024 at RWJ University Hospital, Somerset, New Jersey. He was 81 years old and maintained his smile and zest for life up until the moment of his death.

He was born on Staten Island, New York on January 17, 1943 and as a young boy, moved to Iselin, New Jersey with his family. He was drafted into the US Military, came home, and started his long career in the food and beverage industry. He sold wine and beer, managed restaurants (owning two of his own) and was a catering coordinator for more than

a decade. He continued in the food industry in some capacity throughout his entire life... he even spoke about food in his dreams!

Jim was very involved in the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick, Hunterdon County and in community and church-based activities and organizations. He was an integral part of all the FSSP AfterParty at the Red Mill where his culinary expertise was greatly valued. In 2017, Jim was awarded the FSSP "Spirit of Ireland" award for his contributions to the organization.

Jim was also a 4th Degree Member in the Assembly of the Knights of Columbus.

He volunteered whenever and as much as he could - his concern for those in need was always a priority. He loved tending his herb garden and was the most enthusiastic cheerleader at any sporting event involving a family member. He was a long time Yankees and Giants fan and was always ready for an

adventure. He'd sleep standing up if it meant he could attend a party. The trip of his life was to Italy in 2019 with his son and daughter and friends at his side.

Jim was pre-deceased by his son, David, survived by his daughter, Sarah (Erica), sister, Maryann, brother, Michael (Geraldine), loving nieces and nephews, his former wife and friend, Toni, his two cats, Sammy and Katana and his furry friend, Ted.








2025 Grand Marshal


