I want you to know that my departure is not directly related to any specific person on the Board, but simply due to my need to make my extremely strenuous schedule slightly less demanding. With my remaining time, I would be happy to assist in the effort of finding a replacement and training said replacement so that they are fully prepared come the time of my resignation.
