

- 3. Our Compassion is an extension of God's care over people.








- Mat 10:1 Jesus called his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits so they could cast them out and heal every kind of disease and sickness.
- Mat 10:7 As you go, preach this message: 'The kingdom of heaven is near!'
- Mat 10:8 Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give.

ALL AUTHORITY

Empowered to destroy the works of Satan

- 1Pe 4:7 For the culmination of all things is near. So be self-controlled and soberminded for the sake of prayer.
- 1Jn 5:19 We know that we are from God, and the whole world lies in the power of the evil one.

SOBER MINDED

The task is serious, be sober minded

- Jud 1:9 But even when Michael the archangel was arguing with the devil and debating with him concerning Moses' body, he did not dare to bring a slanderous judgment, but said, "May the Lord rebuke you!"
 - The archangel Michael was sent to bury Moses' body, but according to Jewish tradition (The Assumption of Moses), the devil argued with the angel about the body, apparently claiming the right to dispose of it. But Michael, though powerful and authoritative, did not dare dispute with Satan, so he left the matter in God's hands, saying, The Lord rebuke You!

TO REBUKE OR NOT REBUKE

From G1909 and G5091; to tax upon, that is, censure or admonish; by implication forbid: - (straitly) charge, rebuke.




Figure 4-10: Poverty as a lack of freedom to grow.

Evangelism vs Missions



- Missions and Evangelism is not the same task
 - You can't do Missions without evangelism
 - You can do Evangelism without missions.
- Neil Cole wrote the following about the issue of missions and evangelism "We have made a terrible mistake by separating the convert from the worker. They are not two, but one...Each new convert is a new worker, immediately"

BEYOND OUR COMMUNITIES

Mat 9:38
Therefore ask

- The Church in Africa:
 - Closed churches
 - Church bombings
 - Girls sold to slavery
- The Church in Asia
 - Persecuted by totalitarian states
 - Persecuted by local religions
 - Persecuted by Islamic militants
- Persecution continues to be rampant throughout the world, perhaps more widespread than ever before in history.
- But it can not deter God's Kingdom

PERSECUTION OF BELIEVERS

2 Cor. 4:9-10

- Since the beginning of persecution (1950) by the Chinese state, the church grown from 1 million to 150 million.
 - 'Believers living in the midst of persecution suggest strongly that the goal of Satan is not to beat, torture, or kill believers. The goal of Satan is to..silence believers'
 Nik Ripken (A Missiology of Suffering: Witness & Church Planting in the Midst of Persecution, 2006)

Believers in China:

• 'Pray that we will be faithful in suffering, but do not pray for persecution to be removed lest we become weal and lethargic like churches we hear in the West'

POWERFUL WITNESS

The number one cause of persecution in the world is people coming to Jesus

- The myth of safety is a distortion of the Gospel.
 - God promises His presence
 - God promises healing
 - God promises forgiveness
 - Safety from Persecution...NO
 - Suffering and Persecution often results in a powerful witness for Christ.
 - Stephen, James (Acts)
- Persecution is a form of Spiritual Warfare (Eph. 6:12)

THE MYTH OF SAFETY

The West has distorted the Gospel into a "feel good, prosperity, stop suffering-góspel"

Territorial Entities

- Dan 10:12 Then he said to me, "Don't be afraid, Daniel, for from the very first day you applied your mind to understand and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard. I have come in response to your words.
- Dan 10:13 However, the prince of the kingdom of Persia was opposing me for twenty-one days. But Michael, one of the leading princes, came to help me, because I was left there with the kings of Persia.

DEALING WITH TERRITORIAL SPIRITS

Fallen angels operating in designated territories

They control mindsets, generate worldviews

- Dan 10:20 He said, "Do you know why I have come to you? Now I am about to return to engage in battle with the prince of Persia. When I go, the prince of Greece is coming.
- patron- or guardian-angel. The doctrine of tutelary angels, presiding over the destinies of particular nations, though there appears a trace of the idea in Isa 24:21, and according to some commentators, in Psalms 82,

DEALING WITH TERRITORIAL SPIRITS

Intercessory Prayer

- Act 13:8 But the magician Elymas
 (for that is the way his name is
 translated) opposed them, trying to
 turn the proconsul away from the
 faith.
- Act 13:9 But Saul (also known as Paul), filled with the Holy Spirit, stared straight at him
- Act 13:10 and said, "You who are full of all deceit and all wrongdoing, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness – will you not stop making crooked the straight paths of the Lord?

DEALING WITH WORKERS OF DARKNESS

Elymas o Bar-Jesus distorted the faith of people.

Confronting requires an encounter of power

- Wagner: 'spiritual cartography is for the intercessor what x rays is for a surgeon"
- 2Co 10:3 For though we live as human beings, we do not wage war according to human standards,
- 2Co 10:4 for the weapons of our warfare are not human weapons, but are made powerful by God for tearing down strongholds. We tear down arguments
- 2Co 10:5 and every arrogant obstacle that is raised up against the knowledge of God, and we take every thought captive to make it obey Christ.
- Once you identify the top five vices, you know who and what you are dealing with

MAPPING YOUR TERRITORY

Developing strategies for local communities

- Take a team of intercessors, walk the streets,, identify what's oppressing people:
 - Violence
 - Drugs
 - How many liquor stores/bars in your area?
 - Prostitution
 - What's the divorce ration in your community?
 - Idolatry?
 - Poverty?
 - Witchcraft?

DESIGNING MINISTRY

Design Ministry to destroy the works of the devil in your community (1 Jn. 3:8)




Field Work
