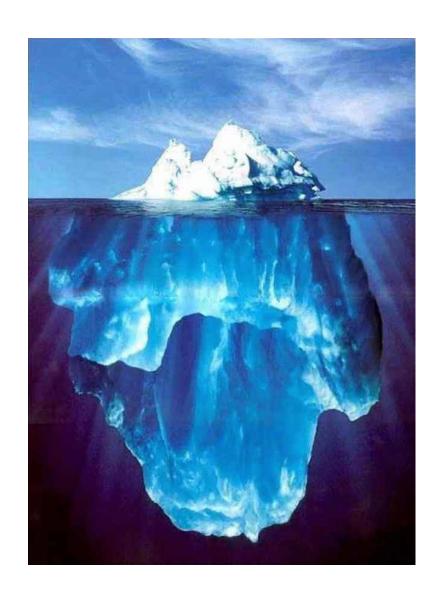

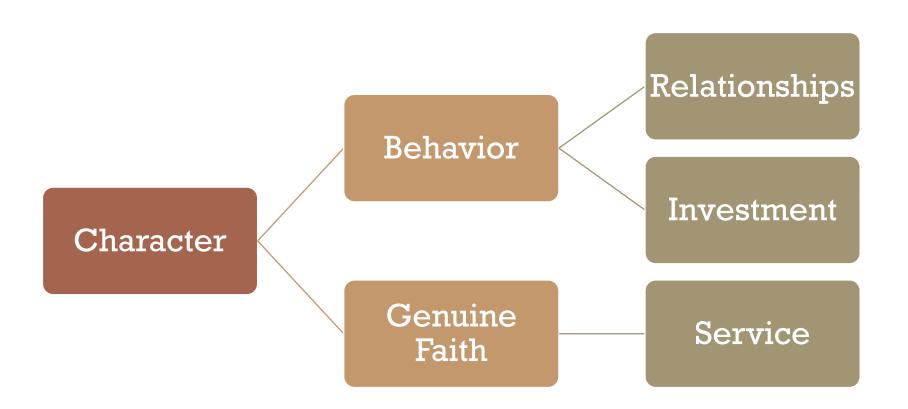

The need for inner healing





- 1. Overcoming Denial:
 - From denial to embracing the truth
- 2. Discovering the Root Cause:
 - Doing away with self help/quick fixes
- 3. Biblical Identity:
 - Seeing ourselves as God sees us
- 4. Overcoming Self Reliance:
 - Relying on Grace
- 5. Taking Responsibility:
 - Owning our lives
- 6. Renewing our minds:
 - Staying open to hope
- 7. Overcoming Isolation
 - Seeking Community

Rediscovering God's grace

Surrendering:

- Coming to the end of our resources.
- Spiritual surrendering is not about losing or being defeated.
- Is about letting go and letting God do his thing.
- Is about Transparency
- Romans 7:15,24:
 - Rom 7:15 For I don't understand what I am doing. For I do not do what I want – instead, I do what I hate
 - Rom 7:24 Wretched man that I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death?
- Give up the idea that that you/we can run our lives effectively on our own

 Required Disciplines to discern God's Voice:

Prayer:

Heb 4:16 Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

• **Psa 62:8** Trust in him at all times, you people! Pour out your hearts before him! God is our shelter! NET

• Meditation:

The discipline of quietness, Calm, stillness, tranquility, serenity

SELF EXAMINATION

- Spiritual healing increases our capacity to receive God's love and grace.
- Sharing this Love catalyzes our healing,
- Compassion:
 - Acknowledging the full humanity of others and learning to see them as God's beloved children
 - Jas 1:27 Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.
- The practice of forgiveness and service are two key ways that we can open ourselves so God's grace can flow into others.

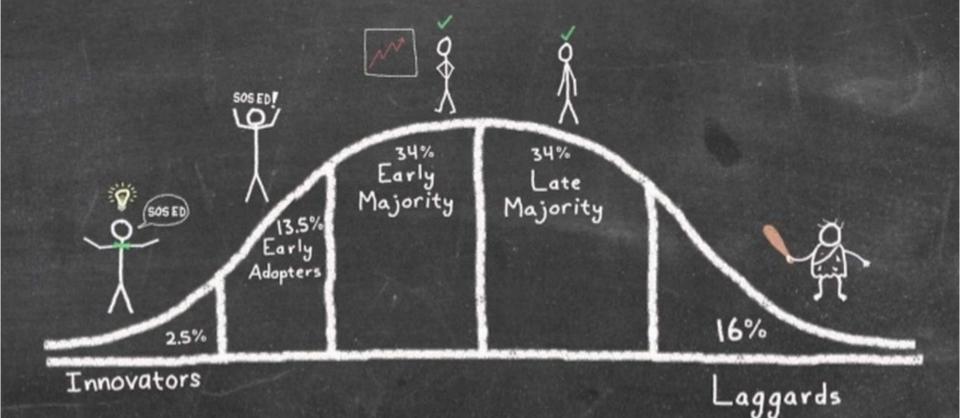

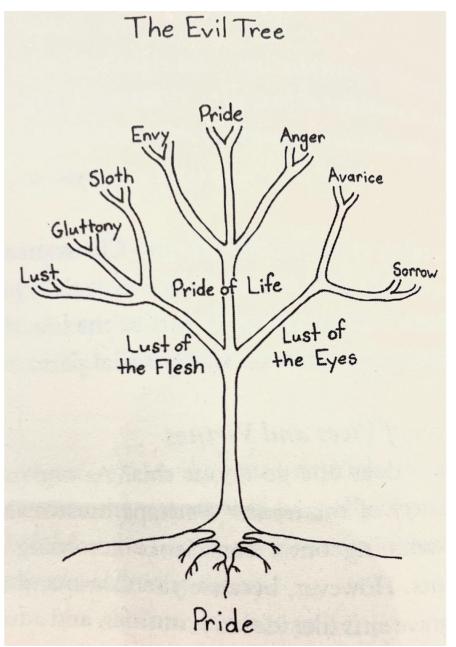


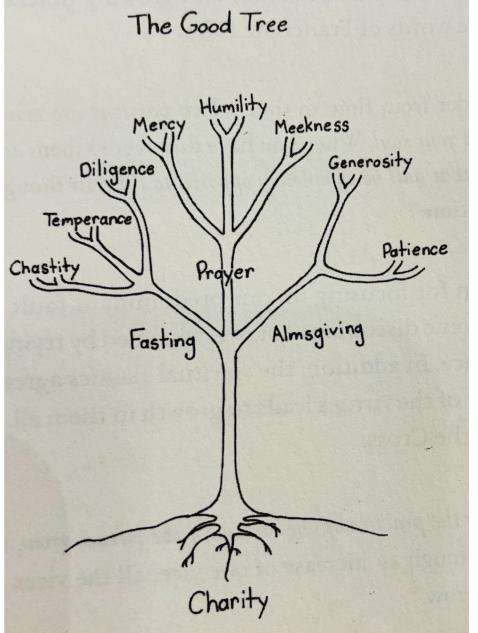

Centering Prayer	To quiet the heart and rest in God alone
Community	Journeying with others
Confession & Self Examination	To surrender & embrace practices that lead to transformation
Covenant Group	Authentic & healing relationships with a committed group of believers
Hospitality	Offering grace, shelter and presence of Jesus
Fasting	Food Abstinence to seek for guidance
Justice	Seeking good, protection, and fair treatment of others
Liturgical prayer	Praying to established patterns of written prayers and readings
Meditation	To deeply gaze on God through the Word and created order
Lament	To take my complaints, anger, suffering to God
Service	Helping, caring and sharing God's love in the world
Silence	Disconnecting from distractions in order to listen God's voice.

Small Group	Spiritual journey with trusted friends
Sobriety	To live with moderation without any vices
