

The divine council represented the heavenly hosts


Eden/paradise, both the divine council and Adam and Eve cohabitated together.

Deu 32:8 When the Most High gave the nations their inheritance, when he divided up humankind, he set the boundaries of the peoples, according to the number of the heavenly assembly.

Psa 82:1 A psalm of Asaph. God stands in the assembly of El; in the midst of the gods he renders judgment.

Psa 82:2 He says, "How long will you make unjust legal decision s and show favoritism to the wicked? (Selah)
Psa 82:6 I thought, 'You are gods; all of you are sons of the Most High.'

Pentecost, God announces the good news

- For the MT יְשְׂרָאֵל בְּנֵיי(bene yisraʾel, "sons of Israel"
- a Qumran fragment has "sons of God,"
- while the LXX reads ἀγγέλων θεοῦ (angelōn theou, "angels of God"), presupposing בְּנֵי אֵל (bene 'elim).
- "Sons of God" is undoubtedly the original reading;
- the MT and LXX have each interpreted it differently.
- MT assumes that the expression "sons of God" refers to Israel (cf. Hos 1:10),
- while LXX has assumed that the phrase refers to the angelic heavenly assembly (Psa 29:1; Psa 89:6; cf. as well Ps 82)

SONS OF ISRAEL OR SONS OF GOD?

Sons of Israel: KJV, JUB, NIV, MKJV

Sons of God: NET, NRSV, NLT

- Gen 6:1 NET
 When humankind (אדם 'adam)began to
 multiply on the face of the earth, and
 daughters (אדמה בת bath 'adamah) were
 born to them,
- Gen 6:2 the sons (בּן ben) of God (בְּנִיהָאֱלֹהִים, haʾElohim) saw that the daughters of humankind (אדם בּת bath 'adam) were beautiful. Thus they took wives for themselves from any they chose.
- Gen 6:3 So the LORD said, "My Spirit will not remain in humankind indefinitely, since they are mortal. They will remain for 120 more years."
- Gen 6:4 The Nephilim (פל / נפיל nephiyl / nephil) were on the earth in those days (and also after this) when the sons of God would sleep with the daughters of humankind, who gave birth to their children. They were the mighty (gibbor) heroes of old, the famous men.

THE EXPERIMENT OF THE WATCHERS

Pre-Flood hybrids, a mix of divine beings and humans.

- 2. Violence
- 3. God shortens men's longevity
- 4. The Flood
- 5. Post Flood Giants

- Sons of God appear on Gen 6:2, Gen 6:4 and in Job 1:6; Job 2:1; Job 38:7.
- Gen 6:4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days (and also after this) when the sons of God would sleep with the daughters of humankind, who gave birth to their children. They were the mighty heroes of old, the famous men.
- N16 Genesis 6:4 (NET+)
 - The parenthetical/explanatory clause uses the word) הַגְּבֹּרְי (hag gibborim) to describe these Nephilim.
 - The word means "warriors; mighty men; heroes."
 - The appositional statement further explains that they were "men of renown."
 - The text refers to superhuman beings who held the world in their power and who lived on in ancient lore outside the Bible.

THE NEPHILIM

ben Elohim



- H430 (Strong)
- **ש**להִים

'elohiym

- el-o-heem'
- Plural of H433;
 - gods in the ordinary sense;
 - but specifically used (in the plural thus, especially with the article) of the supreme God;
 - occasionally applied by way of deference to magistrates; and sometimes as a superlative: - angels, X exceeding, God (gods) (-dess, -ly), X (very) great, judges, X mighty.
- Total KJV occurrences: 2601

(ELOHIYM

Belonging to he supernatural Realm used to described God when used with a particle

Means gods, in reference to the heavenly hosts: angels, archangels, rulers, thrones, either fallen angels of faithful sons of God.

Used to describe the spirits of disembody Nephilims

Used to describe the spirit of disembody humans

Only Yahweh is the Exalted Elohim.



- Gen 7:7 Noah entered the ark along with his sons, his wife, and his sons' wives because of the floodwaters.
- Gen 7:23 So the LORD destroyed every living thing that was on the surface of the ground, including people, animals, creatures that creep along the ground, and birds of the sky. They were wiped off the earth. Only Noah and those who were with him in the ark survived.
- Gen 7:24 The waters prevailed over the earth for 150 days
- Gen 10:9 He was a mighty hunter before the LORD. (That is why it is said, "Like Nimrod, a mighty hunter before the LORD.
- Mighty: אָבּר גְּבּוֹר
- gibbor, gibbor Pronunce: ghib-bore', ghib-bore'
- Intensive from the same as H1397;
- powerful; by implication warrior, tyrant: champion, chief, X excel, giant, man, mighty (man, one), strong (man), valiant man.
- The Epic of Gilgamesh is the oldest written chronicle in the world, composed three to four thousand years before Christ. It tells events in the life of a king in an ancient city of Mesopotamia.

GIBBOR

Means Giants in the context of genesis 6.




Nimrod, Gilgamesh, Apollo.....

- Was a Hybrid
- Genesis 10
- 2/3 divine, 1/3 human
- Posibbly the main antichrist
- 666 as reference to its origin
- Esau killed Nimrod and sold his birthright (Book of Jasher)







The book consists of five distinct sections:

- (1 Enoch 1 36) The Book of Watchers
- (1 Enoch 37 71) The Book of Parables, also called the Similitudes of Enoch
- (1 Enoch 72 82) The Book of the Heavenly Luminaries, also called the Astronomical Book
- (1 Enoch 83 90) The Dream Visions, also called the Book of Dreams
- (1 Enoch 91 108) The Epistle of Enoch The Book of the Watchers date from about 300 - 200 B.C. and the latest part Book of Parables probably was composed at the end of 1st century B.C.

1 ENOCH

Enoch was considered inspired and authentic by certain Jewish sects of the first century B.C and remained popular for at least 500 years.

The earlier Ethiopian text was apparently derived from a Greek manuscript. The original was written in Semitic language, most likely Aramaic.

First discovered in the 18th century. The discoveries of the Dead Sea Scrolls prove the existence of the book of Enoch long before Jesus.

This book influence the New Testament. There are over 100 comments in the NT which find precedence in the book of Enoch.



- 6.1 And it came to pass, when the sons of men had increased, that in those days there were born to them fair and beautiful daughters.
- 6.2 And the Angels, the sons of Heaven, saw them and desired them. And they said to one another: "Come, let us choose for ourselves wives, from the children of men, and let us beget, for ourselves, children."
- 6.3 And Semyaza, who was their leader, said to them: "I fear that you may not wish this deed to be done, and that I alone will pay for this great sin."
- 6.4 And they all answered him, and said: "Let us all swear an oath, and bind one another with curses, so not to alter this plan, but to carry out this plan effectively." 6.5 Then, they all swore together, and all bound one another, with curses, to it. 6.6 And they were, in all, two hundred, and they came down on Ardis, which is the summit of Mount Hermon. And they called the mountain Hermon, because on it they swore, and bound one another with curses.
- 6.7 And these are the names of their leaders: Semyaza, who was their leader, Urakiba, Ramiel, Kokabiel, Tamiel, Ramiel, Daniel, Ezeqiel, Baraqiel, Asael, Armaros, Batriel, Ananel, Zaqiel, Samsiel, Sartael, Turiel, Yomiel, Araziel. 6.8 These are the leaders of the two hundred Angels, and of all the others with them.

- 7.1 And they took wives for themselves, and everyone chose for himself, one each. And, they began to go into them, and were promiscuous with them. And they taught them charms, and spells, and they showed them the cutting of roots and trees.
- 7.2 And they became pregnant and bore large giants. And their height was three thousand cubits.
- 7.3 These, devoured all the toil of men, until men were unable to sustain them.
- 7.4 And the giants turned against them in order to devour men.
- 7.5 And they began to sin against birds, and against animals, and against reptiles, and against fish, and they devoured one another's flesh, and drank the blood from it.
- 7.6 Then the Earth complained about the lawless ones

Introduction of witchcraft, abortion

They were cannibals

Practice of bestiality and crossing of species



10.8 And the whole Earth has been ruined by the teaching of the works of Azazel; and against him write: ALL SIN."

10.9 And the Lord said to Gabriel: "Proceed against the bastards, and the reprobates, and against the sons of the fornicators. And destroy the sons of the fornicators, and the sons of the Watchers, from amongst men. And send them out, and send them against one another, and let them destroy themselves in battle; for they will not have length of days.

10.10 And they will all petition you, but their fathers will gain nothing in respect of them, for they hope for eternal life, and that each of them will live life for five hundred years."

10.11 And the Lord said to Michael: "Go, inform Semyaza, and the others with him, who have associated with the women to corrupt themselves with them, in all their uncleanness.

Judgement against the Nephilim

Fallen Watchers are bound for 70 generations



- Around the third century a theory suggested that the "sons of God" are the descendants of Seth and the "daughters of man" are the descendants of Cain.
- This theory is popular among evangelicals.
- The "sons of God" is to be understood as the posterity of Seth, who from the times of Enosh began to "call upon the name of the LORD" (Gen 4:25)
- Problems:
 - No linguistic Support
 - Discovery of the Dead sea scrolls
 - Book of Enoch
 - Book of Giants:
 - (Expands lEnoch 6-16): Names, dreams, fears
 - Book of Jubilees
 - (Genesis 1- Exodus 19)
 - Archeology

- 2Pe 2:4 For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but threw them into hell (ταρταρόω, tartaroō) and locked them up in chains in utter darkness, to be kept until the judgment,
- 2Pe 2:5 and if he did not spare the ancient world, but did protect Noah, a herald of righteousness, along with seven others, when God brought a flood on an ungodly world,
- 2Pe 2:6 and if he turned to ashes the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah when he condemned them to destruction, having appointed them to serve as an example to future generations of the ungodly,

REFERENCE TO GENESIS 6


Paul, was also familiar with the enochian account and includes a preventive measure to avoid tempting the angels that worship with us.

- Deut. 1:28 What is going to happen to us? Our brothers have drained away our courage by describing people who are more numerous and taller than we are, and great cities whose defenses appear to be as high as heaven itself! Moreover, they said they saw Anakites there."
- Num 13:33 We even saw the Nephilim there (the descendants of Anak came from the Nephilim), and we seemed like grasshoppers both to ourselves and to them."

King Og of Bashan

• Deu 3:11 Only King Og of Bashan was left of the remaining Rephaites. (It is noteworthy that his sarcophagus was made of iron. Does it not, indeed, still remain in Rabbath of the Ammonites? It is thirteen and a half feet long and six feet wide according to standard measure.)

Goliath

- 1Sa 17:4 Then a champion came out from the camp of the Philistines. His name was Goliath; he was from Gath. He was close to seven feet tall.
- 1Sa 17:5 He had a bronze helmet on his head and was wearing scale body armor. The weight of his bronze body armor was five thousand shekels.
- 1Sa 17:6 He had bronze shin guards on his legs, and a bronze javelin was slung over his shoulders.

THIRD GENERATION GIANTS


The remaining clans of hybrids retreated to Philistine.

This is why David cut off Goliath's head.








Comparison between a Hybrid and normal skulls found in Paracas- Perú








Elongated Skulls found in Paracas- Perú

Elohim, Sons of God, Gibbor, Book of Jasher (7, 27), and 1 Enoch (6,7,10)

Yasher 7:24 And the garments of skin which God made for Adam and his woman, when they went out of the garden, were given to Cush.

25 For after the death of Adam and his woman, the garments were given to Enoch, the son of Jared, and when Enoch was taken up to God, he gave them to Methuselah, his son.

26 And at the death of Methuselah, Noah took them and brought them to the ark, and they were with him until he went out of the ark.

27 And in their going out, Ham stole those garments from Noah his father, and he took them and hid them from his brothers.

JASHER

Nimrod Ruled With The Garments Which Elohim Made For Adam And His Woman



Yasher 27:4 And on a certain day Esau went in the field to hunt, and he found Nimrod walking in the wilderness with his two men.

5 And all his mighty men and his people were with him in the wilderness, but they removed at a distance from him, and they went from him in different directions to hunt, and Esau concealed himself from Nimrod, and he lurked for him in the wilderness.

6 And Nimrod and his men that were with him did not know, and Nimrod and his men frequently walked about in the field at the cool of the day, and to know where his men were hunting in the field.

7 And Nimrod and two of his men that were with him came to the place where they were, when Esau started suddenly from his lurking place, and drew his sword, and hastened and ran to Nimrod and cut off his head.

JASHER

The Bible mentions by name the book of Jasher in 2 Samuel 1:18 and Joshua 10:13

1840 the Midrash version of Jasher is the closest to the information revealed in the OT. A comparison between Joshua 10:13 & 2 Samuel 1:18 and Jasher 56:9 proves this point.



Yasher 27:10 And when Esau saw the mighty men of Nimrod coming at a distance, he fled, and thereby escaped; and Esau took the valuable garments of Nimrod, which Nimrod's father had bequeathed to Nimrod, and with which Nimrod prevailed over the whole land, and he ran and concealed them in his house.

Yasher 27:11 And Esau took those garments and ran into the city on account of Nimrod's men, and he came unto his father's house wearied and exhausted from fight, and he was ready to die through grief when he approached his brother Jacob and sat before him.

12 And he said unto his brother Jacob, Behold I shall die this day, and wherefore then do I want the birthright? And Jacob acted wisely with Esau in this matter, and Esau sold his birthright to Jacob, for it was so brought about by Jehovah. 13 And Esau's portion in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham had bought from the sons of Heth for the possession of a burial ground, Esau also sold to Jacob, and Jacob bought all this from his brother Esau for value given.

Esau Stole The Garments



Now Jacob cooked a stew; and Esau came in from the field, and he was weary. And Esau said to Jacob, "Please feed me with that same red stew, for I am weary." Therefore his name was called Edom. But Jacob said, "Sell me your birthright as of this day." And Esau said, "Look, I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?" Then Jacob said, "Swear to me as of this day." So he swore to him, and sold his birthright to Jacob. And Jacob gave Esau bread and stew of lentils; then he ate and drank, arose, and went his way, thus Esau despised his birthright. (Gen 25:29-34)
