Film-Pass – “Film Piracy Amnesty Subscription Service” is offered by Grove Street Funding, Inc.

Through no fault of your own someone in your household may have pirated a film from one of our film producers/copyright holders. As the cable subscriber you may be held liable. We offer you this service.

Grove Street Funding, Inc. (GSF) will provide a “Covenant Not to Sue” (CNS) written agreement to each subscriber. Most copyright infringement cases will run about \$5,000 in damages with an additional \$2,500 in legal fees.

GSF provides \$1,500 of related legal expenses to cover the subscriber in the event a copyright holder seeks copyright infringement damages against the subscriber. The three year subscription gets the subscriber to the end of the statute of limitations.

The first 250,000 subscribers enrolling with the monthly enrollment fee of \$20.00 will be credited with Grove Street Tokens (GST) based on the pre-Initial Coin Offering (pre-ICO) price of five cents (\$0.05) versus the expected ICO price of ten cents (\$0.10)

GST will help blockchain media content whether film, music, or software. GSF will provide support and guidance for independent filmmakers and song writers to register their media with the US copyright office.

80% of the GST issuance will fund and finance copyright related litigation as well as other methods of protection for copyright holders. Via our technology platform we will register and/or blockchain both copyright holders and online infringers agreeing to fair settlement terms for past piracy events.

Introduction & Project Purpose

Grove Street Token (GST) is designed to support efforts fighting online piracy. Our primary focus is for the benefit of media content creators. We finance legal action and settlements mostly for film, television, music, literature, social media, and gaming software content.

Online piracy is a global problem for content creators. Here in the United States, it is estimated that one third of all households pirated some form of media in the last twelve months. We estimate there are 44 million households liable for copyright infringement.

The US Supreme Court issued a ruling on March 25, 2026 in the Cox vs Sony court case minimizing the enabling piracy actions of the country’s Internet Service Providers (ISP). This court decision will refocus attention on the individual end user online pirate. Those that oversee the recovery of copyright

infringement damages will seek DMCA statutory damages up to \$30,000 per pirated title as well as up to \$25,000 in additional statutory damages for those that share illegally altered Copyright Management Information (CMI) per title.

Technology & How It Works (Technical Overview)

It will be important that we can provide blockchain services to the media content creators allowing them to establish a global time stamp for their media.

Tokenomics (Economic Model)

Our target is for 80% of all issuances to be pooled and utilized for defense of copyright holders and other related actions. We will enroll both online end user pirates and film copyright holders. In this manner we will oversee an exchange platform allowing for reasonable settlements to resolve outstanding infringement events. We see a profitable path for GST through litigation funding targeting online piracy. Based upon industry standards, it is estimated a return on investment will be approximately three times the original investment. As an example, \$50 million invested should yield \$150 million. Given our 90% burn commitment, we believe this will lead to eventual higher prices for the GST.

We expect 20% of the issuance of GST will be used for legal fees, marketing efforts, accounting services, audit fees, and management services.

Roadmap:

We began our pre-Initial Coin Offering (ICO) in May of 2025. The first 250,000 GST owners will be considered "Founders" participating at a pre-ICO pricing of five cents (\$0.05) per token. We are targeting the ICO at ten cents (\$0.10) per token.

Risks & Challenges:

1. Market Volatility - The prices of digital assets are highly volatile and are influenced by numerous unpredictable global, regional, and industry-specific factors. The value of your Grove Street Token may fluctuate significantly over short periods, and there is a significant risk that you may lose your entire value or investment.
2. Regulatory and Compliance Risks - Cryptocurrency remains subject to intense, evolving, and often inconsistent regulatory scrutiny across various jurisdictions. New legislation, administrative actions, or court rulings by entities like the SEC or international regulators may severely impact the legality, transferability, and valuation of digital assets.
3. Cybersecurity and Technological Failure - Digital asset networks rely heavily on decentralized software, cryptography, and distributed ledger technologies. These platforms are inherently vulnerable to

cyberattacks, software bugs, and/or coding errors. If a network is compromised, you could suffer permanent loss of your assets with no mechanism for recovery.

4. Custody and Private Key Risks - Access to your cryptocurrency requires cryptographic private keys. If these keys are lost, misplaced, or stolen—whether through physical loss, hardware failure, or hacking of a custodial wallet or exchange—the associated digital assets are unrecoverable. Transactions in digital assets are irreversible.

5. Liquidity and Market Manipulation - The cryptocurrency market is prone to fragmented liquidity, price manipulation by malicious actors, and the concentrated ownership of tokens by a few large holders (whales). These factors may cause sudden and drastic price drops, making it difficult or impossible to sell your assets at a desired price.
