
The Radiator Tool

Used for cleaning in between radiators and other narrow spaces.




The Rug Nozzle

The Hose and Wands




Floor and Wall Brush

Used for cleaning wooden, stone and linoleum floors, also rough plaster, walls and ceilings.




Dusting Brush




Inserting plug into machine.




To use rug or other tools on wand merely place on plain end firmly.




To connect wands place plain end into slotted end of the other wand.

To clean brushes or other tools, run the tool over the wand or hose end a few times while the machine is running.





Cleaning Rugs

The above picture shows Electrolux being used for the purpose of cleaning rugs. Please notice the ease and relaxed position of the operator. Just glide the tool over your rug naturally—no downward pressure is necessary. The quietness of Electrolux makes it possible to clean your rugs at any time.

Cleaning Carpeted Stairs

Use only one section of the wand and the rug nozzle. Glide easily and naturally over the carpeted steps. Please observe how simple it is to thoroughly clean your carpeted stairs with Electrolux. Electrolux is efficient, and adaptable.

Cleaning Draperies, Curtains, Etc.

While you are cleaning your rug and you come to a draped window, merely run your rug tool over the drapery as pictured. You don't need to use a step ladder or a chair with Electrolux.



Cleaning Under Furniture

Reverse the position of your natural hand grip and you will be able to run your rug tool under low furniture. The moving of heavy furniture is not necessary when using Electrolux.



High Dusting

Attach to the end of the wand your dusting brush—run your brush over the moldings, pictures, etc. Electrolux is thoroughly efficient and easily operated.



Low Dusting

Use the same brush on the end of the wand and operate it as desired, on lower surfaces such as baseboards, etc. Electrolux is flexible and able to meet all of your cleaning problems.





Cleaning Corners of Rooms

Remove the tool that you were using from the end of the wand and place the wand in the corner to be cleaned. Your Electrolux provides a complete home cleaning system.

Cleaning Wooden, Stone and Linoleum Floors

Attach your large brush to the wand and use in the same manner as when you are cleaning rugs. The brush will not only clean your floors thoroughly but will automatically put a lustre on your polished surfaces.

Dusting Lamp Shades, Etc.

Use the small round brush attached to the natural hand grip end of the hose and operate as desired, on silk or parchment lamp shades. You will be pleased to note how easily you can now clean such heretofore difficult surfaces.



Dusting Furniture, Etc.

Use the same brush as already suggested above. You will be able to remove the dust from carved and odd-shaped furniture as well as flat. You can reach and meet all demands with this brush in furniture dusting.



Dusting Piano Keys, Etc.

Use the same brush as you were using when dusting your furniture. The soft bristles of the brush do not scratch the ivory surface of the piano keys, yet thoroughly cleans them. Electrolux is adaptable to any cleaning requirements and of course you understand that no dust can escape from Electrolux at any time.



Dusting Interior of Radios

This same brush is used to dust the interior of your radio. Very often static noises are caused by dust particles settling on the radio connections. We suggest that at least once a week you dust the inside of your radio to insure proper reception. However, be sure that the radio is turned off. Electrolux is one hundred per cent dust proof.




Cleaning Upholstered Furniture



Cleaning Furs

Use the small nozzle attached to the natural hand grip end of the hose and operate in a convenient manner. You will find that Electrolux will thoroughly clean your furs and it will also revive and improve their appearance. Electrolux is a great machine.



Cleaning Clothing

Use the small nozzle attached to natural hand grip end of the hose as you may desire. You can thoroughly clean all kinds of clothing and felts easily and quickly. Electrolux will meet all of your cleaning demands, quietly and with the utmost efficiency.



Cleaning Blankets and Pillows

Use small nozzle attached to natural hand grip end of hose as desired or as pictured. Blankets and pillows should be cleaned often to insure sleeping with safety. Electrolux will not only thoroughly clean blankets and pillows, but it will also retain all of the material matter it withdraws from your blankets and pillows, thereby preventing recontamination of the air and fine dust from settling anywhere in the bedroom.



Cleaning Mattresses

Use the small nozzle attached to the natural hand grip end of hose as pictured. The average person spends a third of his life sleeping on mattresses, and to prevent a harmful condition while sleeping, you should Electrolux your mattresses often. The high suction and the convenient nozzle attachment of Electrolux will insure thorough cleaning. Electrolux has received more than one hundred highest awards for its hygienic and technical perfection.





Cleaning Dogs, Pets, Etc.

Use small nozzle attached to natural hand grip end of hose and operate as pictured. The soft quiet purr of your Electrolux will not disturb or scare the pet. The suction passing through the fur of the animal is soothing and relaxing. All the material matter removed from the animal will be retained in the Electrolux dust trap, because of its unusual construction.

Removing Bon Ami, Etc., from Mirrors and Windows

Attach the small round brush to the natural hand grip end of the hose and operate as pictured above. Allow the Bon Ami to dry, and merely run the brush over the surface where you desire to remove the Bon Ami. You will find this a very quick and thorough method of removing Bon Ami. Electrolux is a very important part of your household equipment.

De-Mothing


To Attach Vaporizer



Place the crystals of Expello No. 4 in the vaporizer. To attach the vaporizer, hold machine and vaporizer as pictured herewith and screw the vaporizer to your right in the exhaust end of the machine. The vaporizer is special equipment for which there is a slight extra charge. Expello No. 4 may be purchased from an Electrolux representative or may be obtained from drug or department stores.

To De-Moth Garments in Closets

Place the machine in the closet with the vaporizer attached to the exhaust end as shown by the picture on this page, then turn on the current and close the closet door, making the closet practically airtight. The Electrolux Vaporizer is so constructed that the air passing through comes in contact with the volatile crystals of Expello No. 4 quickly forms a heavy chemical gas for demothing purposes. Because of the exclusive Electrolux principles, the air in the closet is being continuously recharged while the machine is in operation, resulting in a very high effective density of the gas.



The Electrolux Vaporizer and Expello No. 4

It is a recognized fact that practically every household desires to protect its upholstered furniture, clothing, furs, etc., against moth damage.

One of the present methods is to take Paradichlorobenzene Crystals which are recommended for de-mothing purposes by the United States Department of Agriculture (for detailed explanation see Farmers Bulletin No. 1655, Page 28) and scatter them by hand on the materials desired to be de-mothing, in some instances these crystals are scattered mechanically. After these crystals are scattered, they are left to vaporize naturally. This vaporization is very slow at normal room temperatures, thereby resulting in a low gas concentration, except when confined in air-tight containers and only reasonably effective at room temperatures of 70 degrees Fahrenheit or higher (see United States Department of Agriculture Farmers Bulletin No. 1655, Page 28). For proper de-mothing the gas must have a sufficient concentration which is difficult to obtain with only the normal vaporization. Expello No. 4 is a form of Paradichlorobenzene Crystals specially prepared for use with Electrolux.

The Electrolux vaporizer embodies a new exclusive principle producing a gas of very high concentration immediately from the crystals of Expello No. 4. This high gas concentration is obtained by vigorous rotary agitation of the crystals with preheated air which converts the crystals into an effective gas. Because of the exclusive efficiency of this method, a higher gas concentration is obtained than with the same amount of crystals left to normal slow vaporization. The terrific power with which this gas is directed to the materials desired to de-moth, forces this chemical gas into the tissues of the fabric itself thereby effecting a contact at the vital spot of the material.

It is important that every household should take the necessary precautions to protect its materials subject to moth damage in the proper manner. The annual damage done by moths is a tremendous figure.



Cleaning Walls

Atach your large brush to the end of the wand firmly and operate the brush as pictured herewith or as desired. You will be able to thoroughly and efficiently clean your walls without the use of step ladders, chairs, etc., with absolute safety. Electrolux the great machine, is undoubtedly the best machine.

Cleaning Screens, Etc.

Place large brush on natural hand grip end of hose and operate the brush as pictured above or as desired. The bristles of this brush are very firm and you will note that it does a thorough job of cleaning screens, rough surfaces, etc. Electrolux is, without doubt, the most complete cleaning system available.

The Electrolux Filter

The filter pictured herewith is of double thickness with an air space between the front and rear sections, and is used to insure absolute clean air only to return to the room. This filter has a life of six months. We suggest that you replace it at the end of each six-month period.



Removing or Changing the Filter

Unclasp the exhaust end of the machine, and take hold of the special filter pad grip and pull the pad out entirely. Burn the old pad, insert fresh one in its place. This filter pad is valuable protection to you. It is strictly an Electrolux feature.

Removing Dust Trap

Place machine vertically as pictured herewith, unclasp in-take end, remove trap as pictured. The Electrolux dust trap is removed quickly and easily without coming in contact with any dust or dirt.



To Empty the Dust Trap

Empty the dust trap on a piece of paper as pictured herewith, take hold of the special dust trap grip, and shake thoroughly, allow the dust and dirt to settle before removing the trap off the paper. When the trap is empty, return to cylinder of machine. Burn the dust and dirt.





Attaching Electrolux Sprayer

Place hose on exhaust end of machine and insert sprayer on the natural hand grip end of the hose. The sprayer is special equipment and for which there is a slight extra charge. You may purchase a sprayer from any Electrolux bonded representative or by telephoning the local Electrolux office.



Electrolux Spraying

Because of the unusual volume of air displacement that Electrolux has, it is possible to spray very effectively and quickly. You are able to spray insecticides, wax, etc. The thickness of your spray is easily regulated by a slight movement of the operator's thumb over the opening at the top of the sprayer.



Drying Your Hair with Electrolux

Place Electrolux on a convenient table or stand without the hose being attached. Start the machine and permit it to run for a few minutes until the air gets warm, then allow the Electrolux air to circulate through your hair and over the scalp.
