Re: Du Cane Kunzea Oil

I have been surprised and somewhat delighted to find another clinical use of this oil. I have been using I.V. Sodium ascorbate in practice for some twenty-five years. If given on a daily basis only four or five doses can be given. Thereafter the vein becomes so irritated that further injections have to be postponed for at least seven days, usually longer, thus delaying treatment.

In one recent case I used Du Cane Oil, simply rubbing it in two or three times that day after the injection. The result was that I was able to give over two hundred consecutive daily injections with no ensuing irritation at all. The therapeutic response is surprisingly fast. With one patient almost instantaneous. I have used Du Cane Oil in seven cases so far. All in patients with cancer.

Oncology treatment demands many I.V. injections and the same problems arise as with Sodium ascorbate. Du Cane Oil gives promise of being of significant effect in routine every day Oncological therapy with chemo therapeutic agents, and of course in other areas of medical care.

In another condition, Atopic Eczema, this Oil seems to be useful in local application to skin. In one particular case the result was very significant. It deserves further investigation.

Hello Mr. Hood...I am writing to tell you how delighted I am with your product, Kunzea Oil.

I am a registered nurse and therefore fully aware of the implications of what I am writing.

I have used it, topically on recurring shingles (Herpes Zoster) and while it does not stop the recurrence, it takes the fire and to a great degree, the itch, out of the affected area, to the degree that it does not worry me.

To whom it may concern, I am writing with regard to Mr. John Hood's product Kunzea oil. I am very pleased to have it at my disposal & utilize it regularly. I find it particularly useful as a topical application for inflammation & bruising. The following are 3 examples of the particular uses I have put it to:

- 1) An elderly lady on warfarin therapy finds that she bruises very easily. She uses Kunzea oil applied neat to any area which she has knocked & finds that it prevents the unsightly purple marks usually associated with this type of injury.
- 2) A 30 year old male suffered an eye injury from a squash ball. Some 3 hours later the eye had begun to swell & bruise, his vision was unaffected. Kunzea oil applied neat to the eyelid & surrounding area halted the bruising process. It did not reverse any bruising but no "shiner" developed.
- 3) A 30 year old woman slid down some steps on her skis with only minimal skin damage. Application of first cold water then Kunzea oil caused mild tingling of the area. No bruising was visible the next day although the area was still tender to the touch.

I currently use Kunzea oil on any injury that does not involve large areas of broken skin. I find that best results are obtained when the oil is applied as soon after the injury as possible.



- a drop on the window sill with the window open provides a refreshing aroma within the room all day.

Thank you for the opportunity to trial your Kunzea oil. As you know I then bought a substantial supply for continuing use.
