

Pre-Procedure Instructions

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY RESULT IN THE CANCELLATION OF YOUR APPOINTMENT - SHOULD THIS OCCUR, YOUR BOOKING FEE WILL *NOT* BE REFUNDED OR TRANSFERRED TO A LATER DATE

Step 2: Set Your Skin Up for Success!

- **HEALTHY skin = easy procedure = beautiful results**. You need to be on a regular cleanse-tone-moisturize-SPF regimen. For inexpensive & effective skincare, I recommend: https://ca.theinkeylist.com
- Please exfoliate the area to be tattooed in the days leading up to your appointment, but be gentle! Removing dead, dry skin ensures optimal results. Note: this is not necessary for eyeliner appointments.

Step 3: Be aware of the following information, especially as your appointment gets closer:

Avoid these 24hrs before your appointment:

- Caffeine (one SMALL cup in the AM is ok if absolutely necessary)
- Aspirin/ibuprofin (blood thinners)
- Alcohol
- Fish Oils/Vitamin E (natural blood thinners)

Avoid these in the weeks leading up to your appointment:

- Do not wax/tweeze/tint the area within 1 week of your appointment
- No facials or chemical peels within 2 weeks of your appointment
- No botox/filler treatment within 2 weeks of your appointment
- Avoid UV exposure on your face 2 weeks before and after your appointment. If you show up with a burn, your procedure will be cancelled.
- Discontinue vitamin A/retinol products 4 weeks before your appointment

Special Notes by Type of Procedure

LIPS

- Exfoliate with a sugar scrub in the week leading up to your appointment. For very dry lips, I recommend "La Neige Lip Sleeping Mask" or any lanolin-based product. If you show up with dry lips, your healed result will be patchy. It is YOUR responsibility to ensure that your lip tissue is healthy before you arrive at the studio.
- Know that lip blush can trigger a cold sore flare up, especially if you have had a cold sore at any time in the past. Many people have the HSV-1 virus laying dormant in their system, and the trauma of lip blushing can cause a breakout. Please see your doctor for preventative antivirals such as Valtrex (or similar) for 5 days before/after your appointment.
- Consider purchasing Aquaphor Healing Ointment in advance of your appointment! It's a great daily lip balm, and it will help you during the healing phase. This product can easily be found at any Shoppers Drug Mart or Walmart location.

EYELINER

- You MUST stop the use of any lash growth serums a minimum of 3-months prior to your eyeliner appointment
- I cannot and will not tattoo through lash extensions please have them completely removed at least 72hrs before your appointment
- You cannot wear mascara/eye makeup for 10 days after your procedure. If this concerns you, I would recommend getting a lash lift & tint a week before your appointment.

BROWS

- Txfoliate and moisturize the brow area well
- Avoid using any anti-aging products on the forehead/brow area 2 weeks before your appointment.

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
