## Mini/Petite Combo Classes:

- Appropriate shoes must be worn depending on the styles of dance. (See class styles below)
- Dancers can wear whatever they are comfortable moving in.
- Hair must be pulled away from their face.
- No jeans.
- I recommend having an extra set of clothes in dancers' dance bags in case of accidents.

## Ballet:

- Leather ballet slipper for ages 3-6 years old.
- Canvas ballet slipper for ages 7+
- Black leotard and pink tights
- Hair must be pulled away from their face. A bun is preferred.
- No jewelry other than studded earrings.

## Tap:

- Black tap shoes
- Dancers can wear whatever they are comfortable moving in.
- Hair must be pulled away from their face.
- No jeans.

## Jazz:

- Natural or tan jazz shoes
- Dancers can wear whatever they are comfortable moving in.
- Hair must be pulled away from their face.
- No jeans.
