

- Membership and program privileges are not transferable from one person to another
- Unless an organizational error has occurred, we do not offer credit, refunds, or makeup classes
- Membership payments must be up to date in order to use the facility
- Class registration fees must be paid in advance
- Rates and schedules are subject to change
- Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a Parent/Adult (18+) Guardian who must remain in the building
- Memberships are year-long commitments. All monthly memberships are subject to 12 payments equivalent to the annual membership price. All balances are due upon cancellation of a membership
- Pro-rated pricing is not available, regardless of start date
- Memberships do not guarantee a spot in any class




