Officer of The Month: Officer Stuper



Officer Stuper was dispatched to 355 N. Logan St. on a burglary in-progress. Dispatch related that a male wearing a red hooded sweatshirt, red beanie and dark pants is trying to gain access to the parking garage of the Bromwell Apartments. Dispatch also advised the suspect's vehicle is a white station wagon parked in the handicap parking spot. Officer Stuper arrived on scene and observed a Hispanic male matching the description run and hide in front of his vehicle on the ground. The male was ordered out from behind the vehicle and placed into custody. Upon clearing the license plate of the suspect vehicle, it was discovered that the listed plate belonged on a white in color 2007 Acura. The plate that was affixed to the rear of the vehicle had an ATL (Attempt to Locate) for burglary. A clearance of the VIN revealed the vehicle was reported stolen out of Denver. The suspect was also found to have a warrant out of the Department of Correction for a parole violation in regard to a burglary conviction.



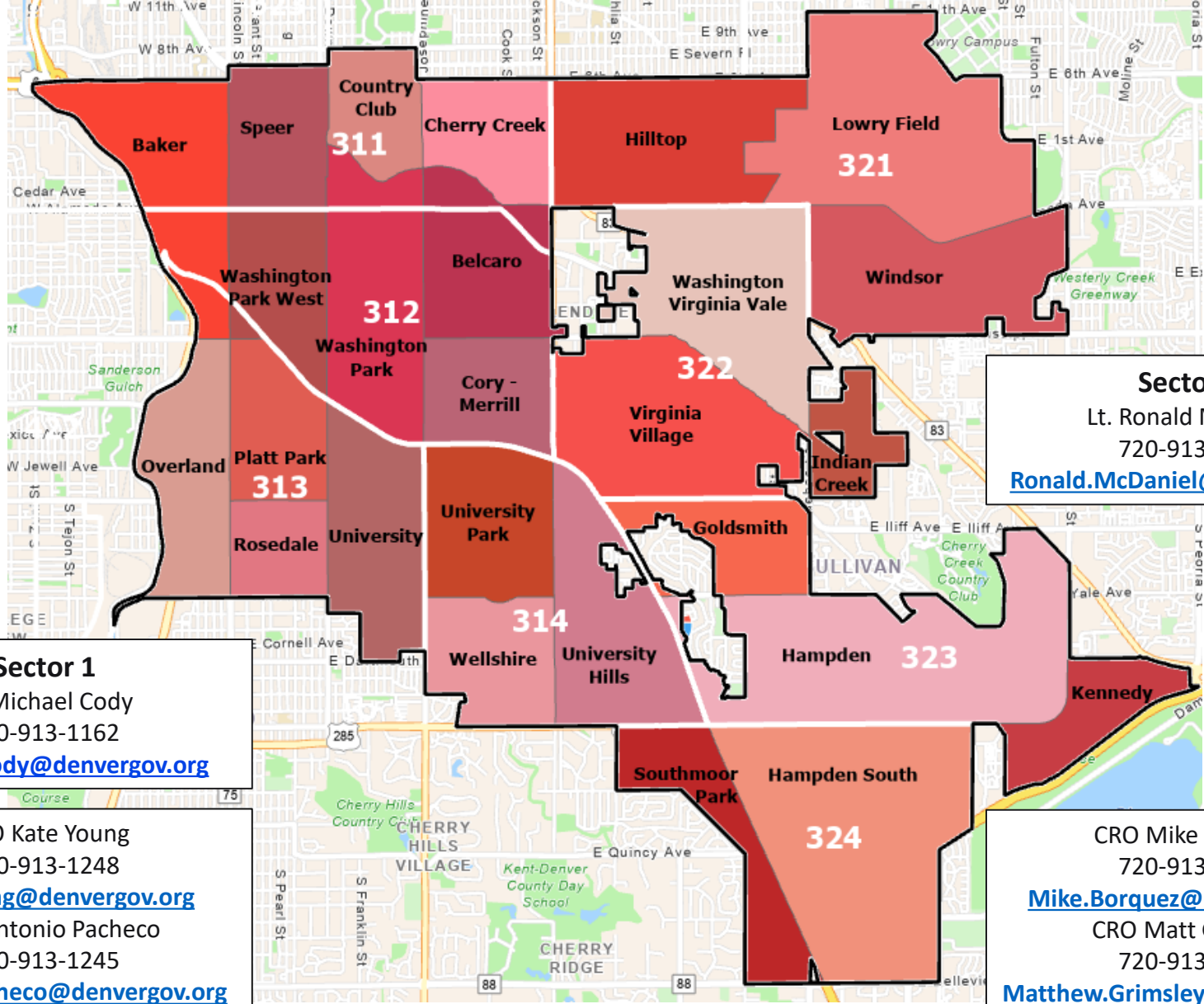

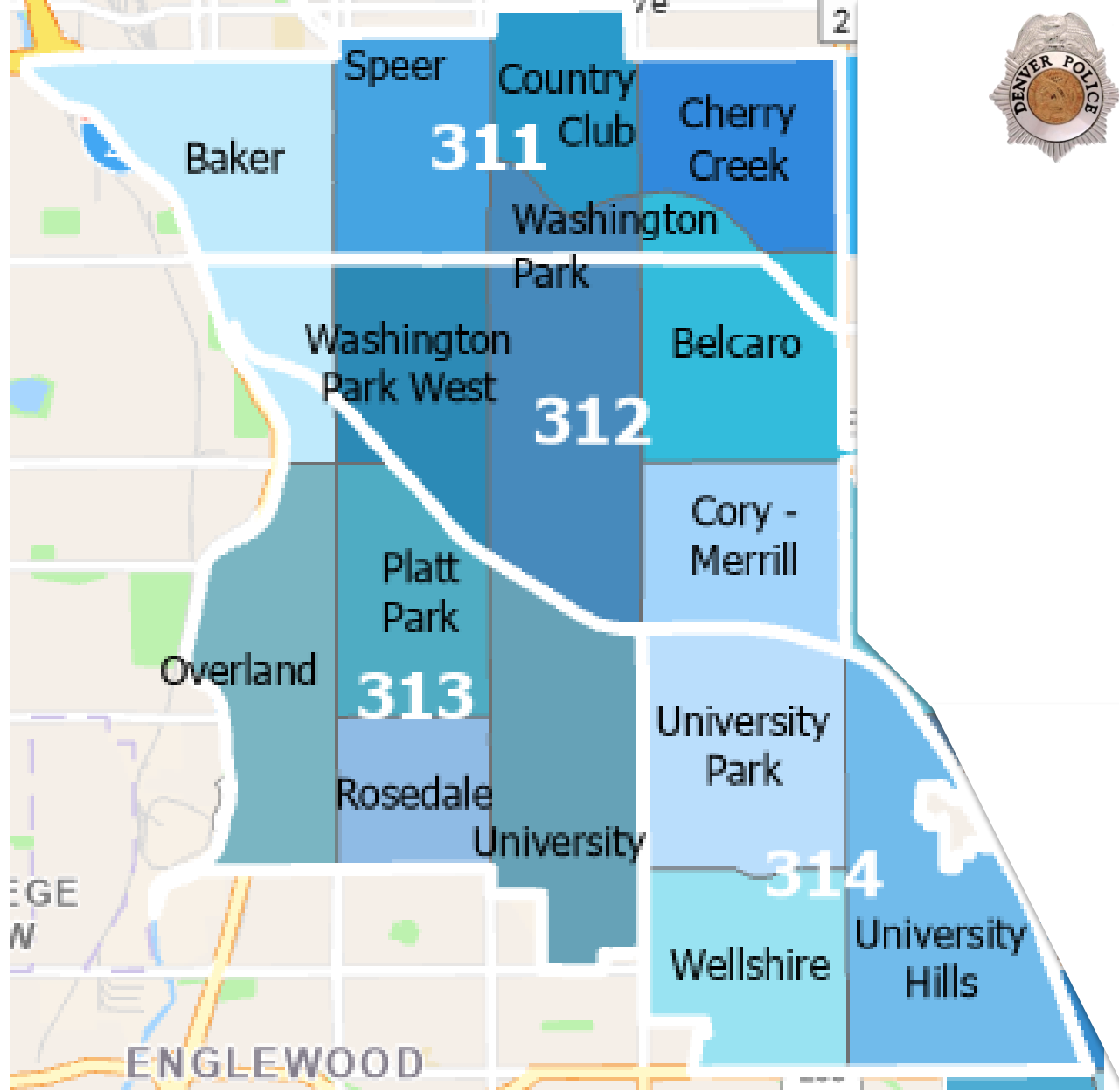

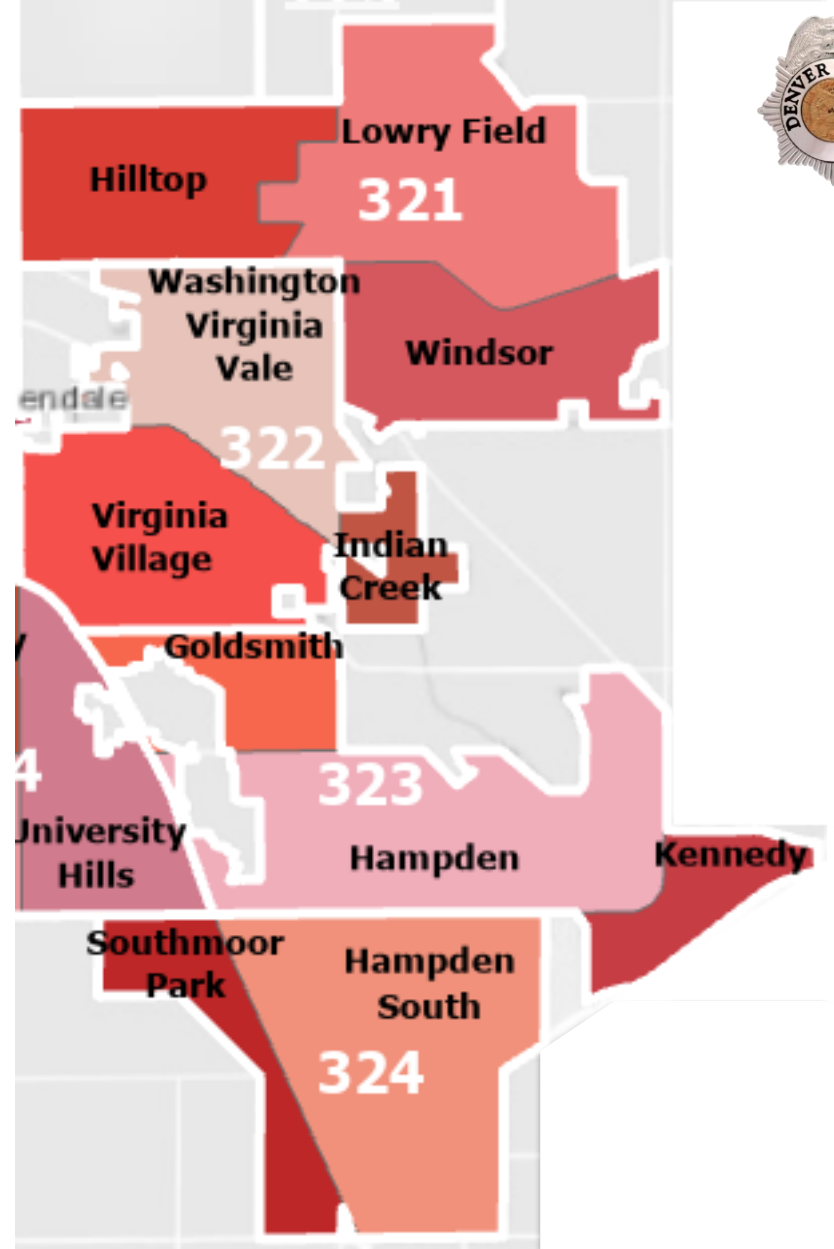
