BULBOPHYLLUM TRISTE



Origin: Asia

Temperatures: Cold to warm growing small size orchid species

Light: Bright shade

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, fully deciduous – no fertilizing from October, only light mist during the wintertime.

General care: Deciduous Bulbophyllum need abundance of water and fertilizer when actively growing, with high humidity, but need to stay dry and not fertilized after losing leaves and going dormant in late fall and winter. Blooms usually appear when waking up from dormancy first, late winter and early spring, followed by new growths, once you see new sprouts, start watering and fertilizing again. Does well outside in Florida, in shade location, brighter in the winter time.
