DENDROBIUM STRONGLANTHUM



Origin: Burma

Temperatures: Intermediate to warm growing small orchid species

Light: Bright shade

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, goes dormant – stop fertilizing in October, stop watering when all leaves fall off – resume watering and fertilizing in the spring when new growths appear.

General care: Gorgeous miniature size deciduous Dendrobium species from Burma, clusters of hanging blooms when going dormant. Grows best under intermediate to warm conditions, in bright shade, good humidity and good air movement. Fully deciduous – stop fertilizing in October, reduce watering in the fall and stop watering when leafless over the winter – resume watering once new growths appear in late winter/spring. Light misting every 7 days to prevent canes from shriveling too much is recommended. Can be grown potted or mounted – likes to grow hanging down. Great plant for terrariums, vivariums, greenhouses and outdoors in proper zones.
