

## **CORYBAS ANNAMENSIS**



Origin: Vietnam

**Temperatures:** Cold to intermediate growing miniature terrestrial orchid

species

Light: Bright shade

**Watering & Fertilizing:** This is a terrestrial orchid that has a specific growing cycle – regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, keep much drier when dormant.

General care: Probably smallest terrestrial orchids with very specific growing habit - they start to sprout from dormant stage with fuzzy looking stem, grow 1 leaf, then bloom that can last for weeks if sufficient humidity is provided, new tubers will appear on rhizomes at the end of the growing season, leaves will die and plants will go dormant again – you will be left with leafless tubers that you will keep much drier till spring! Annamensis does differ slightly compared to other Corybas species and your original tuber will not usually die after the cycle is finished, it'll go dormant and sprout again for the next season (we know growers that observed this for over 5 years).
