Origin: Africa

Temperatures: Warm to cool growing small size orchid species

Light: Bright light

<u>Watering & fertilizing:</u> Regular watering and fertilizing in active growth, much drier in winter time when bulbs go dormant and loose the leaves, shade.

General care: Everyone must fall in love, one of the most interesting orchid species with pseudobulbs shaped like famous Hershey's chocolate kisses. This orchid goes completely dormant for the winter and produces big pinkish blooms anytime between spring to fall on leafless or with leaves bulbs. Follow dormancy requirements, regular watering when dormant will lead to rot of pseudobulbs. Water and fertilize abundantly in active growing season. Grows best under hot to cool conditions, in bright shade or filtered light, with good air movement. Best when grown potted. Great plants for windowsills, greenhouse growing and outside in proper zones.
