

BULBOPHYLLUM SANITII



Origin: Asia

Temperatures: Warm to cool growing small size orchid species

Light: Bright shade

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing year-round.

General care: Still uncommon in cultivation, this miniature size Bulbophyllum need abundance of water and fertilizer when actively growing, with high humidity, but need to stay dry and not fertilized after losing leaves and going dormant in late fall and winter. Blooms usually appear when waking up from dormancy first, late winter and early spring and are super cool on long stems with dozens of blooms rotating around resembling windchimes. Followed by new growths, once you see new sprouts, start watering and fertilizing again. Grows well under intermediate to cool temperatures, in bright shade, high humidity and air movement. Can be grown potted or mounted. Great for windowsills, greenhouses and outside in proper zones.
