

CATTLEYA / LAELIA LILIPUTANA



Origin: Brazil

<u>Temperatures</u>: Cool to warm growing miniature size orchid species <u>Light</u>: Bright light

Watering & fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing year-round General care: One of the smallest of Cattleya species, endemic to Minas Gerais in Brazil grows on the stones and rocks and produce cute pinkish blooms. Although they are described as cold growing, we have great success growing them outside in Florida year-round. As all Cattleya species, these will root from new growths and bloom from new growths too. Best grown cold to warm, in bright light, direct sun possible when plants are acclimatized to it, good air movement and drying out between waterings. Potted or mounted, if potted, use media that will allow drying, or stone mix, if mounted, very little or no moss. Great plant for windowsills, greenhouses and outside growing year-round in proper zones.
