

CHYSIS 'MARITZA BIELECKI'



Origin: Cross

Temperatures: Hot to warm growing small size orchid cross

Light: Bright light

<u>Watering & Fertilizing:</u> Regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, less in winter & no fertilizing from October.

<u>General care:</u> Beautiful orchid cross thrives in hot and humid conditions. Although it seems similar to Catasetum and Mormodes species, Chysis is not completely deciduous plant. It will lose leaves on oldest mature pseudobulbs, but you should never stop completely watering. Water and feed heavily in active growing season to make sure pseudobulbs are fat – this is the key to blooms! In the winter time, less water and no fertilizer if you do not have any new growths. However, if there are new growths growing over the winter, keep regular care. Great for outdoor / indoor growing, windowsills or greenhouses. Can be grown in Florida outside year-round.
