

## **COELOGYNE APICULATA / PANISEA APICULATA**



Origin: Southeast Asia

**Temperatures:** Cool to warm growing small orchid species

*Light:* Bright shade

**Watering & Fertilizing:** Regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, goes semi - deciduous, majority of old leaves will fall off for the winter – no fertilizing from October, and no watering with only light spraying during the winter time to keep pseudobulbs from shriveling.

**General care:** One of rarely seen small orchid species in collections, this is beautiful and sometimes unappreciated orchid plant. Cute large blooms appear in late winter / spring. Compact small grower, and easy to grow too. Bright shade, cool to warm temperatures, potted or mounted. This is semideciduous species, old leaves will fall off, there maybe some new growths throughout the winter time, stop fertilizing in fall, and spray only lightly in the winter time till new growths appear in the spring. Great for outdoor / indoor growing, windowsills or greenhouses. Can be grown in Florida outside year-round
